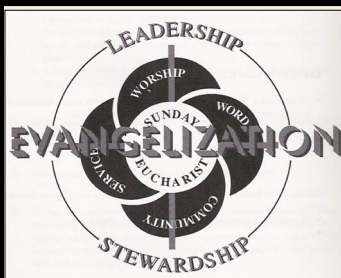

~ A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M. ~

Many of you have matriculated through professional graduate schools – law school, med school, “B” school to name but three. I am graduated from priesTschool, with the “T” pronounced clearly please!

Among our classes was Scripture or Bible Study. For the most part it seemed to me that the professors of Bible Study were like the biology professors, the one who has to kill the frog to study it. So in scripture studies, we killed God and Jesus to grasp the text. And the grasp was an intellectual understanding of scripture as science which doesn’t advance one’s spirituality one comma.

Relating to today’s reading; is it important to know about Lake Tiberias? Does its place on the globe, size, depth, tide patterns, or type and size of fish found in it advance your relationship with Jesus? The charcoal fire has an interesting literary place, it’s referred to elsewhere. Is the number 153 important? Perhaps to Rain Man alone. In the long reading for today – the three questions mimic Peter’s three denials, the verb “love” in the question: “Do you love me” changes from agapao (love that pours itself out to others) to phileo (the deep love between friends as in Philadelphia). Google search the meaning of the two! Hum... Interesting questions to ask and information to find. Is an understanding of God or a relationship with Jesus advanced with this study?

The study of the Scripture could invite us to examine **Jesus**. What is Jesus doing in this gospel teaching? Today he is giving orders and asking questions. Little more. Can you imitate Jesus in this way? Well, yes, until someone tells you: “Hey, you are not Jesus! Now, stop giving orders and starting doing something worthwhile!” Sometimes “full-steam-ahead” is NOT the command. Likewise sometimes giving orders is NOT the way to imitate Jesus.

Psst... There is another way to study today’s Gospel lesson which might lead to a deeper spiritual life and to the fullness of faith. Are there other characters besides Jesus and what are they doing? Yes there are. Rambunctious Peter recognizes Jesus and follows his commands. By doing so he catches a lot of large fish. When Jesus is recognized, he becomes the friend and teacher of the disciples. **He tells them to do the ordinary thing and with his help extra-ordinary results become routine.**

In our everyday lives there is greatness, there is the fullness of life. No matter the size of our lake, Jesus is waiting to give us life in abundance when we realize we are not alone. Jesus exists without limits – the Risen Christ has more life than he can handle, he gives it away freely – so that he can continue to be used as love is for using. **Somehow he finds his glory and joy in sharing our common lives. That can only happen when we let him in. There is a catch!**

As I study today’s gospel lesson, I ask; “What will give faith to life and life to faith?” The answer is to recognize Jesus and follow his command. To form a relationship with Jesus who will redeem and resurrect all life. Renewed, let’s invite Jesus into our lives and by our lives, glorify the Lord.

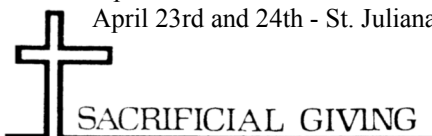

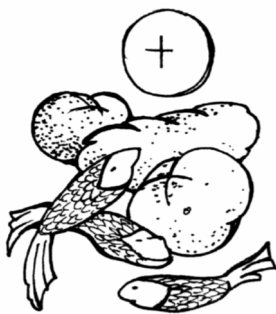

## JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY

Third Sunday of Easter

How appropriate today's Gospel for this *Jubilee Year of Mercy*, both because of the "breakfast" Jesus provides ("a charcoal fire with fish on it and bread") and the number of fish in Peter's net ("one hundred fifty-three") (John 21:11-12). Of the fish, Saint Augustine suggests that the roasted fish is the suffering Christ. Saint Gregory the Great adds that Christ lowered himself to swim in the "water" of our humanity; to be caught in the "net" of our death; to be "roasted" in his Passion on the fire of suffering. Saint Jerome claims that "one hundred fifty-three" represents the full number of known species of fish, signifying that the Church's "net" has room for all our widely diverse humanity, securing our unity-in-diversity in the hands of Peter and his successors. Having received God's mercy as "the beating heart of the Gospel," may the Church—we—"pattern [our] behavior after the Son of God who went out to everyone without exception"

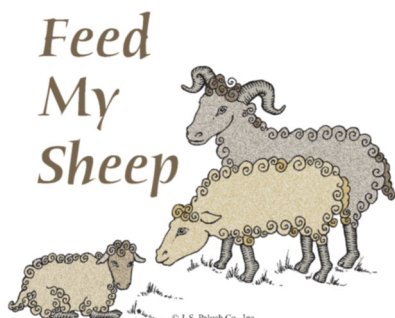

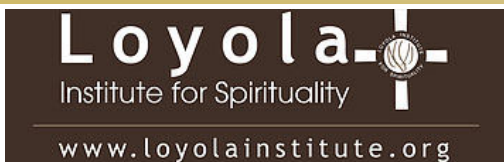

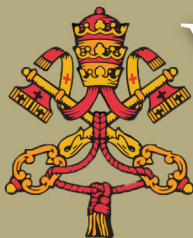
### MORE CORAZON NEWS

On Friday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, Martha Garay and her husband Vidal received a new roof on their house in Valle de Las Palmas, a small town south of Tecate. Martha has been involved as a Corazon volunteer for 3 years. She teaches sewing, handicrafts, and cake baking at the Corazon community center. Her children are already grown. We found their house to be very neat and clean, inside and out. The roof was covered with a plastic tarp up to this point. The weather near Tecate is extreme and a properly tarred and shingled roof is necessary for the house's survival. Martha and her husband were grateful for the support they received from their sponsors.
