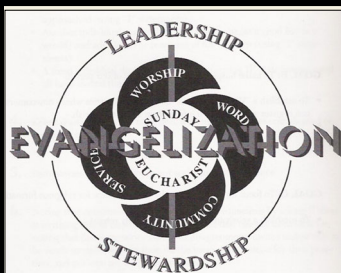

~ A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M. ~



Let's review the previous lesson. The Sacrament of Penance is a sacrament of healing. As you live your life, you desire to receive the mercy of God in a special way. In this sacrament you encounter Jesus Christ who reconciles all things to himself. You desire to "reform your life and believe in the Good News."

Your preparation includes acknowledgement of sin. You know you have turned away from the right and chosen to do the wrong. Your conscience tells you so. You can name your sins. You feel sorry for those actions and seek pardon for them. That's the contrition part! "The genuineness of penance depends on heartfelt contrition. Conversion should affect a person from within so that it may progressively enlighten him and render him more like Christ" (taken from: *The Rite of Penance*). You are preparing your new life of grace by contrition and conversion.

The next step is to step in to the confessional – either behind the screen and speaking anonymously to the priest or face-to-face to the priest. Either way the priest welcomes you with a greeting and possibly a passage from scripture, especially to invite the presence of God into what is sacred time.

It is customary to use this form (or one like it): **I confess to almighty God...** now you tell your sins to the priest. This is the confession part! You must confess those sins which are serious. These sins are acts which are very serious in themselves, you know they are very serious in themselves, and you gave full consent to do an act that is very serious in itself. Honestly, I am not sure we commit such sins often. Our other sins are venial sins. These sins should be mentioned as you work toward eliminating those acts from your life as you strive to live a life that is "holy and pleasing" to God.

The priest then might give some words of counsel or mercy or even praise for being such a good person. Good people come to confession, the really bad stay away; just my opinion. Then he prays the prayer of absolution. The essential words to this prayer are: **I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.** Like the Prodigal Son, you receive the mercy and gifts of Our Heavenly Father and are received back to the community.

Lastly, you are given some act of penance. This penance should help you to renew your life.

Allow the grace of the sacrament to renew your life with God and His community, the Church. Leave the confessional or area where the sacrament was celebrated praising God.

The sacrament can be celebrated anywhere where privacy is protected and at any time. It is appropriate to celebrate the sacrament especially during Lent. During Lent and Advent many parish communities might come together with several priests to reconcile the faithful in a "communal penance service." The same form described above is followed.

Remember the gospel of St. Luke 6:39-45 which teaches us to notice our own behaviors, even more than the behavior of a neighbor. Remove what is preventing us from seeing clearly. Then to produce good fruit.

Let's practice the gospel by the way we live our lives!



JOURNEY OF FAITH

We are on a long and eventful journey. Today's readings for Trinity Sunday succinctly cover the depth and breadth of our human travels.

The very beginnings of our journey are revealed in the reading from Proverbs. God's plan filled with divine wisdom was born before the earth was made. In today's Gospel, Jesus speaks of his own personal journey. He has come from the Father and will return to the Father. Only then will the Advocate—the Spirit of Truth—take us onward.

This does not diminish the fact that the journey will be hard. The very setting of the Gospel is the night before Jesus died. As Saint Paul writes to the Romans, "[W]e even boast of our afflictions, knowing that affliction produces endurance, and endurance, proven character, and proven character, hope" (Romans 5:3-4).

Ultimately, our human journey is modeled by the Holy Trinity—a family of love among Father, Son, and Spirit that we are all called to emulate.

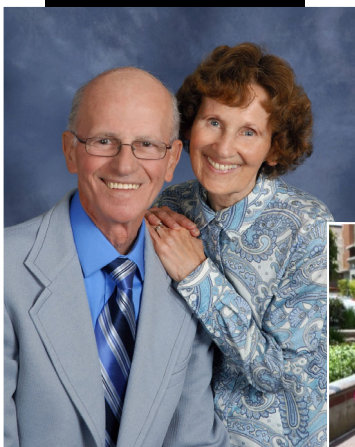

JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY

May 22, 2016

Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

The word *mercy*, Pope Francis declared in his announcement of the *Jubilee Year of Mercy*, “reveals the very mystery of the Most Holy Trinity” (*Misericordiae Vultus*, 2). For *mercy* is how God comes to meet us; *mercy* is the fundamental law helping us recognize everyone as brothers and sisters; *mercy* is the bridge connecting God and humanity, opening our hearts to the hope of being loved forever despite our sinfulness. God’s self-revelation as a life-giving, love-sharing Trinity of Persons draws us closer to God in friendship and communion. Both Judaism and Islam consider *mercy* one of God’s most important attributes. Israel unceasingly proclaims God is boundless in mercy. Islam addresses the Creator as “Merciful and Kind,” believing divine mercy limitless, its doors always open. 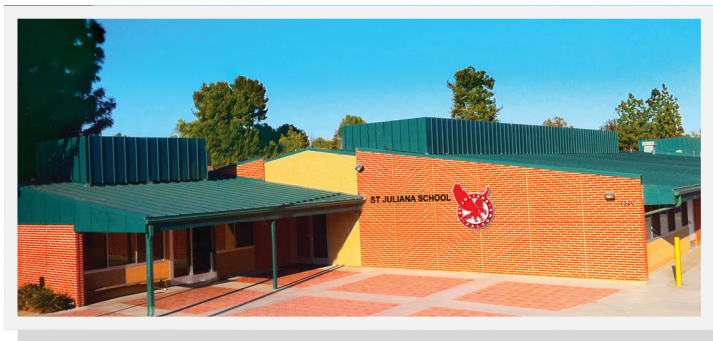
