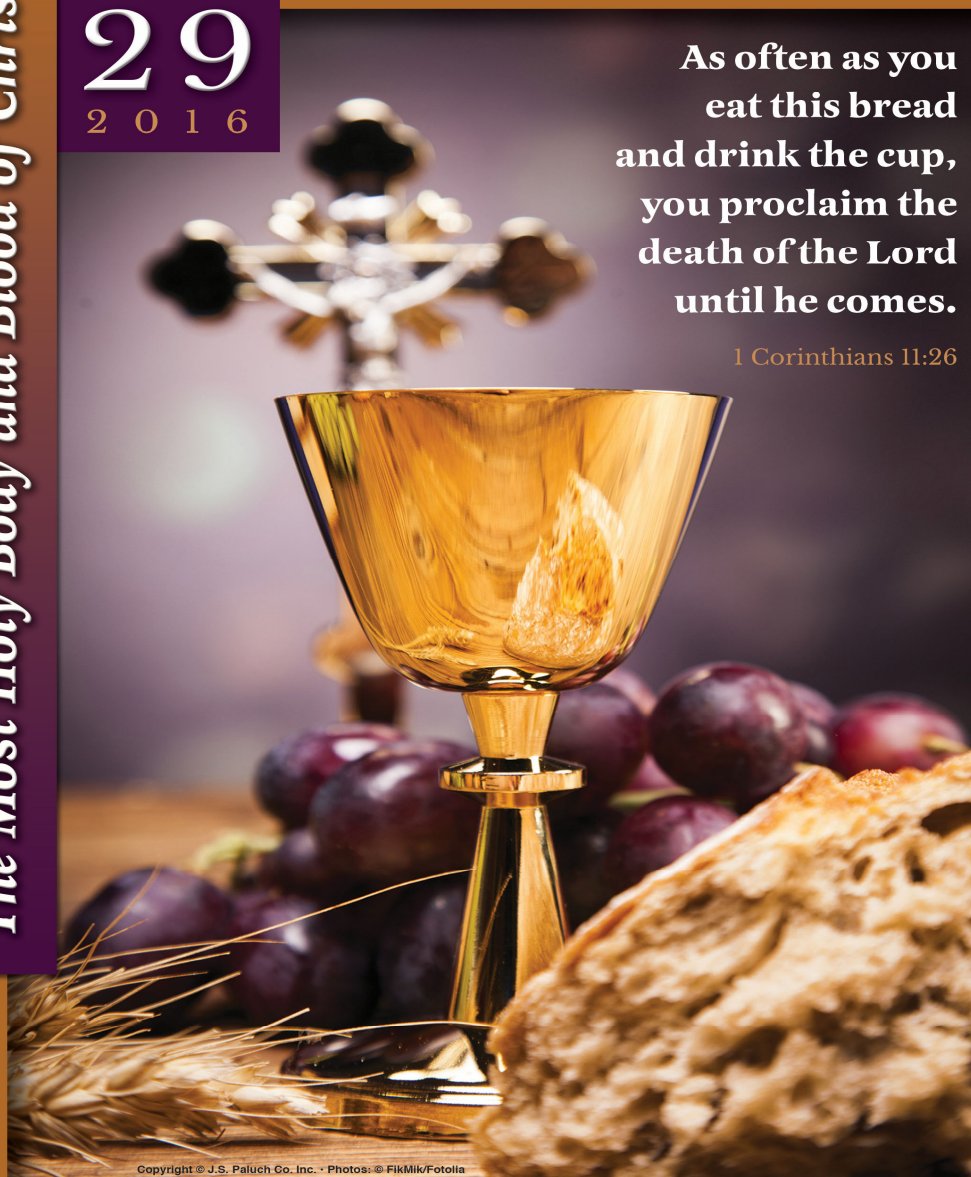

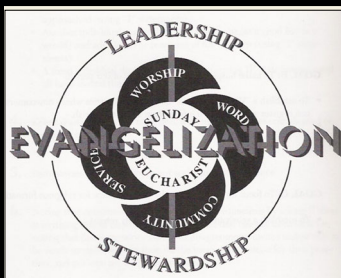

~ A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M. ~

“Extreme Unction” or “The Last Rites” (not rights!) “is more fittingly called ‘Anointing of the Sick’, it is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death.” (The Rites of the Catholic Church)

Historically, the term “extreme unction” or “last anointing” was used in the Middle Ages and continued through the Council of Trent which taught the sacrament would be administered at the end of life, “the anointing of those about to die.”

Vatican II desired to return this sacrament to its earliest meaning; the “anointing of the sick.” It is a richer base borne in scripture (St. James 5:13-16) and pastoral tradition.

Blessed oil has for a long time been regarded as an instrument of healing. Its purpose was to heal the body and bring spiritual strength to the infirm. It wasn’t until sometime in the ninth century that such an anointing became a rite for Christians. Finally, sometime in the early Middle Ages a ritual reserved to priests was created. Further, it was created for those “in danger of death.” Thus, this ritual became, “Extreme Unction” and “The Last Rites.”

Vatican II in its document “*Sacrosanctum Concilium*” - “*The Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy*” - which was the first completed work of Vatican II, directed #73 “Extreme Unction, which may also and more fittingly be called ‘Anointing of the Sick’ is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as any one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the appropriate time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived.”

Thus, the first purpose of the ritual has been restored; the purpose of physical and spiritual healing.

Let’s say it again and be clear: the “anointing of the sick” is given to the sick for healing. In medical practice today there is attention given to physical healing and spiritual awareness. As we are often reminded: “spiritual and bodily effects are not independent of each other, the bond between them is significant.”

Mr. Phi Tran, the Director of music ministry for the Sunday 5PM “Youth Band Mass” submitted his resignation as Director of the Youth Band on May 12. This weekend is his last one with us. He will return to Life Teen youth ministry and become the Director at Holy Trinity Parish in San Pedro. Phi, we are grateful to you for your service to the St. Juliana Catholic Community for the past four years. Thank you for your leadership and support. You are a good and faithful servant – pray for us as we pray for you.

Please begin to set calendar dates: On Sunday, July 31, let’s celebrate Faith, Family, and Food – I have invited Fr. Jack Wall of the Archdiocese of Chicago to be the celebrant and speaker of our Sunday 5:00PM Mass. Fr. Jack is a dynamic pastor who engaged and grew Old St. Pat’s Parish in Chicago from a dwindling community to a vibrant parish. Feel free to GOOGLE his name and read about him. I will have a brief article available to you shortly. Following Mass, there will be Sunday food in the parish center. Mass, food, and a talk for the family. Bring your friends – bring your enemies!

Our Fall Festival is getting started now! The Fall Festival will be Friday, Saturday, and Sunday September 23, 24, and 25. Your help is needed and necessary. John and Maureen Kohaut are the coordinators of the Festival. Their contact information is on the opposite page. While you are looking at the opposite page, might there be some opportunity to serve the community that catches your soul?

The Diocese of Orange is celebrating its Fortieth Anniversary. Founded in 1976 our diocese is forty years old. A festive Sunday is scheduled on September 18 at Christ Cathedral. More information will follow.

Happy Corpus Christi Sunday – may the Body of Christ flourish in this community. May it mean for us what it meant to St. Juliana, our patroness – life in abundance. Spend time in prayer with the Blessed Sacrament. Body of Christ, Bread of life; be our food, be our strength today and always.

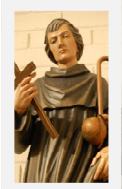

**JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY**

**May 29, 2016**

Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

In this *Jubilee Year of Mercy*, the Lectionary’s Year of Luke presents a Gospel in which Jesus, who has welcomed, taught, healed, and shown God’s mercy to the multitude, refuses the Twelve’s demand to dismiss the crowd before him. Instead, he says, “Give them some food yourselves” (Luke 9:13). In Jesus’ hands, what little the Twelve has feeds five thousand (“men,” and probably as many women and children), leaving twelve baskets so the Twelve can continue Jesus’ ministry of mercy. Pope Francis has asked how *we* celebrate and live the Eucharist. Do we keep it to ourselves? Or do we “commune” not only with Jesus but with the multitude whom Jesus has given us to cherish? Entrusted to Jesus and shared with others, our limited resources can go a long way. Recognizing Jesus in the Eucharist demands that we recognize Jesus also in the hungry crowd. Adoring Jesus present in the Eucharist requires that we serve Jesus present in our neighbor.

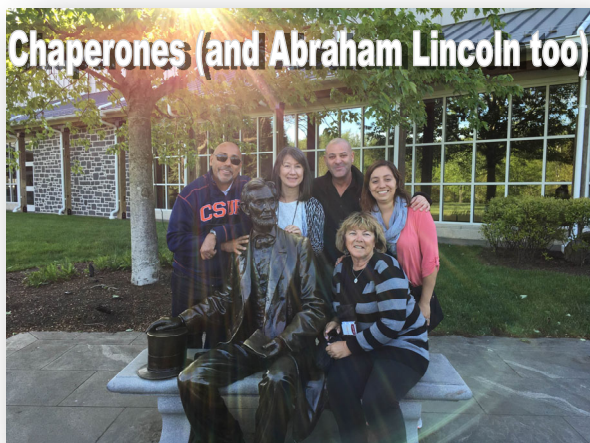

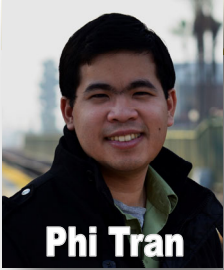

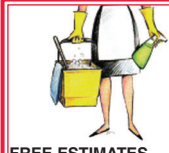
