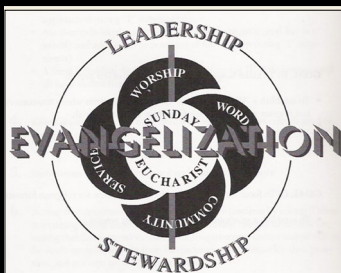

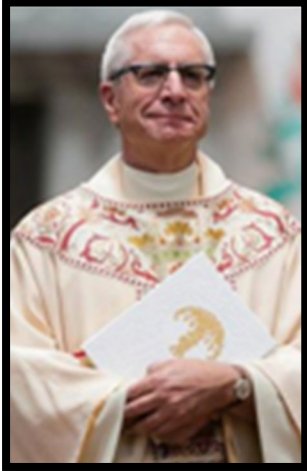

~ A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M. ~

The Sacrament of Penance and the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick are grouped together under the title: “The Sacraments of Healing.”

Let’s begin with the Sacrament of Penance. The sacrament is known by a variety of names: (the) Sacrament of Confession, Sacrament of Reconciliation, and Sacrament of Forgiveness. Officially it is the Sacrament of Penance.

There are several acts associated with the sacrament: The act of a faithful person recognizing that he/she has sinned and reciting those sins to a priest. Through the mercy of God, the act of forgiving the acknowledged sinner and reconciling the sinner with God and His Faithful People. The act of penance on the part of the contrite one; penance being a virtue. Finally, the act of conversion, the turning away from sin and aiming for virtuous habits of behavior.

Reconciliation happens in some form in Baptism, Eucharist, and the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Of the sacraments, Penance stands apart from the others as the one which celebrates in a singular way an acknowledgement of sin and a conversion of heart; a *metanoia* on the part of the penitent.

Let us begin with a brief understanding of sin and the moral life. One definition of sin is “missing the mark.” Sin is doing what is forbidden (commission) or not doing what is necessary (omission). Knowing the right action, a wrong was chosen. Either the bull’s eye or perhaps the entire target was missed. Most often this wrong is simply wrong and not hugely wrong. That’s the difference between “mortal” and “venial” sin. Mortal sins, which must be confessed at least once a year, **are in themselves HUGELY and SERIOUSLY wrong, you know** they are HUGELY, SERIOUSLY wrong acts, and **you give full, deliberate, and conscious consent** to do a HUGELY, SERIOUSLY wrong act. Venial sins are not so seriously wrong in themselves. The way to avoid sin is obey the commandments and to avoid the capital sins, the source of sin: pride, covetousness, lust, anger, gluttony, envy, and sloth.

The best way to learn the moral life is to teach virtue, the right act. Aim at the right, avoid the wrong: “Do acts such as these that you will live.” Sometimes it will mean that you must pause to discern the right or even ask someone else, an expert, to help aim you in the right direction, God’s direction before you act. (Even Pinocchio paused to give a little whistle. Nike, with their shibboleth, “Just Do It” cannot be taken literally as good moral direction.) The life of the community and your life as a single member of it is raised when desires are ordered and actions are directed toward the right. When our natural inclinations are directed in the right way, we live virtuously. Take pride that you belong to a community and do not harm its name, or your own. Be sure to help especially the least of our members. Appreciate what is ours and do not despise or be pre-occupied with what other people have or who they are. Be pure in thought, word, and action. Order the passions rightly; be temperate with food and alcohol. Be more industrious than you are lazy. The four cardinal virtues: **prudence** which gives order to reason, **justice** which orders the will, **temperance** and **fortitude** which order the passions order all guided actions toward the right.

An examination of conscience is incomplete if the virtues are not part of it. Along with the four cardinal virtues be sure to include mercy and justice. Through the virtues we seek to “be holy (perfect).”

The goal of the Sacrament of Penance is the continual conversion of the faithful follower of Jesus. “Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel.”

Be healed from the burden of sin. In the Sacrament of Penance, receive the Lord who is rich in mercy.

As we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord today – let us celebrate our ascension to a better way to live the Christian life through the life of grace we experience in the sacraments of our Church.

JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY

May 8, 2016

Seventh Sunday of Easter / The Ascension of the Lord

Between Ascension and Pentecost, the apostles “devoted themselves with one accord to prayer, together with some women and Mary the mother of Jesus” (Acts 1:12–14). Mary’s presence at the center of the disciples’ circle of prayer provides “a source of comfort and strength,” says Pope Francis, for Mary’s “entire life was patterned after the presence of mercy made flesh.” At the foot of the cross, Mary witnessed Jesus’ forgiveness of his executioners, a supreme expression of the depths to which God’s mercy can reach. “Mary attests that the mercy of the Son of God knows no bounds and extends to everyone, without exception,” Francis notes. Being able to live that unconditional forgiving mercy is the grace we pray the Holy Spirit to bestow. During these days of prayer before Pentecost, in this month dedicated to Our Lady, “may the sweetness of [Mary’s] countenance watch over us,” Francis prays, “so that all of us may rediscover the joy of God’s tenderness” (*Misericordiae Vultus*, 24).

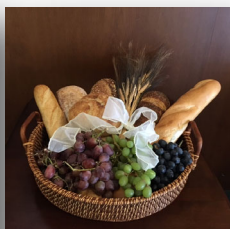
