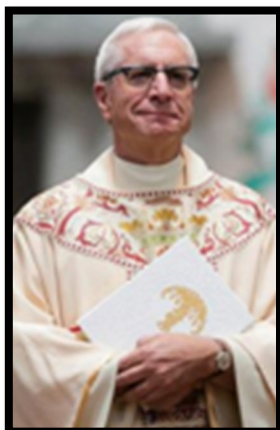

## ~ A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M. ~



Along with being the 11<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary time and Father's Day, June 19<sup>th</sup> is the feast day of St. Juliana Falconieri, the patroness of our parish community.

St. Juliana was born into the Senatorial Falconieri family in Florence, Italy in 1270 when some of the seven Founding Fathers of the Servite Order were still living. According to an early biographer, Fra Paolo Attavanti, when Juliana was fifteen years old, she heard her uncle, Saint Alex Falconieri, one of the Seven Founders of the Servite Order, speak on the final judgment. From that moment, she was so inspired by his words that she dedicated herself to contemplating God and following Jesus Christ. Further, she began to visit the Servites more regularly and eventually inspired a group of other young women to dedicate themselves to Jesus and Mary following the example of the Seven Founders of the Servites. Juliana's holiness was demonstrated in many ways, but most especially as she approached death. As she lay dying she desired to receive the Body of Christ but was unable to consume the host because of illness. A priest was asked to simply place the host on her scapular, which he did. After her death the host could not be found, but had miraculously entered her body and left its imprint on her scapular. She died on June 19,

1341 and was canonized in 1737. Today St. Juliana's body is preserved in the basilica of the Servite Order, Santissima Annunziata in Florence.

*Lord God, through Saint Juliana you raised up a community of consecrated women within the family of the Servants of Mary. May we be so inspired by the teaching of Jesus that we may respect the dignity of others and live our lives in holiness and service. May we also be inflamed with love for you and for the Bread of Life with which Saint Juliana was wonderfully fed at the hour of her death. Amen.*

Fr Luke and I are proud of our patroness and this community formed in her name. We are best when we imitate our saint – praising God in the Eucharist, prayerful at Mass, treating one another with compassion and mercy, and learning our faith through our Catholic school and faith formation opportunities. **There is a growing Servite Secular community in our parish that has a special dedication and devotion to St. Juliana; perhaps you have a calling to it. You are invited to attend inquiry meetings. Contact information is found in the bulletin.**

St. Juliana holy cards are available in the vestibule of our church. You will also find cards to help with the Sacrament of Penance, the Thomas Merton prayer card, cards for vocation interest, 2016 PSA, guides to a holy life, and the Catholic newspaper for the Diocese of Orange. It's all for you, visit the back of the church!



Today's gospel lesson is the question of Jesus' identity: "Who do the crowds and who do you say that I am?" In confessing him to be the "The Christ of God" Jesus tells his chosen students to lose their life and take up his life. Not a bad lesson for us to learn from our fathers! Yes, Dads, on your best days you offer courage to take a course and follow it, you offer faith when there is doubt, and courage when we might be cowards.

Yes, lose your life and follow the guide of your father. Please, dear Dad, take us for a car ride, get us lost, and don't ask for directions. Honk the horn at people who are in the way. Can we end up at 31 Flavors when it's all over? How about just watching the Disneyland Fireworks in the car together!

I hear power tools especially air tools and think of Dad the mechanic. I think of Dad the handy one when I buy what he would have made and replace what he would have repaired. I see mechanical wrist watches being repaired and think of Dad the jeweler. I watch WWII movies and think of Dad the soldier under General Patton's command. He was interesting and filled with stories. Dad was from Chicago's Taylor Street Italian community!

After my own father died, I also have very fond memories of a man who looked after me as if I belonged to his family. Was he ever a hoot!

Today tell Dad how much you love him and appreciate all he does for you. Let him do things with you. One day all the conversations and activities, even the ones you never had, will be a memory. Pray that day is well into the future and does not come suddenly.

May God bless the fathers of St. Juliana Falconieri Catholic Community. May these men be strengthened as Christian fathers. May we honor them always with a spirit of profound respect.
