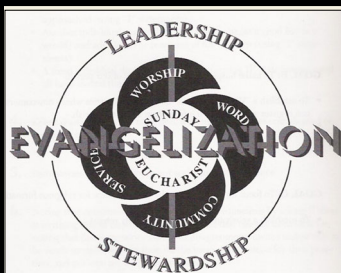

## ~ A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M. ~



The second collection on June 11/12, next weekend, will benefit the Servite mission of Zululand, the north-western part of South Africa in the Province of KwaZulu-Natal.

The missionary effort of the Servites, which is part of the missionary effort of the Catholic Church, began there in 1946. Today the Church is spreading among the Zulus, the largest ethnic group in the Republic. They are a proud and happy people, strong, and hardworking. The Zulus are a deeply devout people who love to pray and worship God. Their worship services are long and lively – filled with song and dance – hymns and devotions are celebrated in their own language and culture. All-in-all, the faith grows in all of Africa at the rate of a bit more than two million Catholics per year.

Your “on-going generosity” has built a beautiful parish church and mission out-post churches, a retreat center, schools, and AIDS hospice centers. The buildings are centers for the community to gather, to be healed, to be educated, and to worship God.

There is a growing indigenous clergy as-well-as growing communities of religious women. It is still somewhat dangerous in the mission – every now and again the homes of the clergy are broken into and goods/jeeps are taken. From time-to-time even a missionary is killed.

One measure of success is the indigenous clergy – that clergy comes from another success, a High School, specifically Star of the Sea High School. It has the reputation of being one of the best college preparatory high schools in the area. The young people who attend it study hard, the school’s passing rate on national standardized tests approaches 100% - this is in a nation where the average passing rate is 52%.

Another success is a medical center and the AIDS hospice center where we offer medical care to all who come to our door. More centers and staff are needed. The AIDS pandemic in Africa has left the area with many orphans.

Since 1946 our missions have been offering Christian initiation, community and worship, education, medical care, and works of charity to those who without us would not know Christ. An active Catholic faith mission has been built and paid for by the generosity of those who wish Jesus’ gift of the fullness of life for all people.

The local Church covers less than 10% of its budget. To continue the good works already begun depends on the generosity of people who recognize that if not stoked, the fire might go out. Your generous donation today will be a sign of hope for the clergy and joy for the People of God.

What has been started depends on your help to continue to prosper.

By your charity may the good work which was begun, continue. Onward Christian Soldiers let us not grow weary and lose heart. With eyes fixed on the Savior who told us our neighbor is the one in need – may we be neighbor to the unseen but ever present face of Christ.

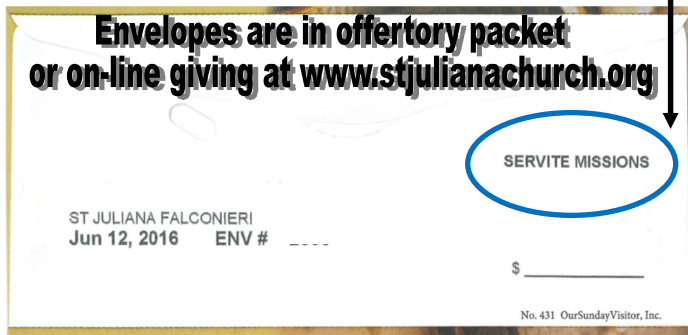

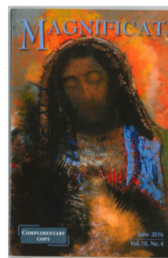

### JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY

June 5, 2016

#### Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Half the liturgical year 2016 is completed after six months of *extraordinary* celebrations. The Incarnation mystery: Jesus' advent, nativity, epiphany. The Paschal mystery: Jesus' passion, death, resurrection, Pentecost's Holy Spirit. The solemnities of Holy Trinity and Jesus' Body and Blood. Today the Church resumes Sundays in Ordinary Time, but with a Gospel of *extraordinary* mercy: Jesus raises a dead man to life. Yet the one who benefits most from his *extraordinary* mercy is not the dead son but his widowed mother. With her husband and only son deceased, this woman's material support, in that patriarchal society, had vanished. So had her emotional support, leaving her helpless, abandoned, on society's "peripheries." One of Pope Francis' hopes in calling this *Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy* is to transform us into more *extraordinary* Christians, by making our caring outreach to just such vulnerable people, and our practical self-sacrificing love for them, our *ordinary*, daily, Christian way of life!

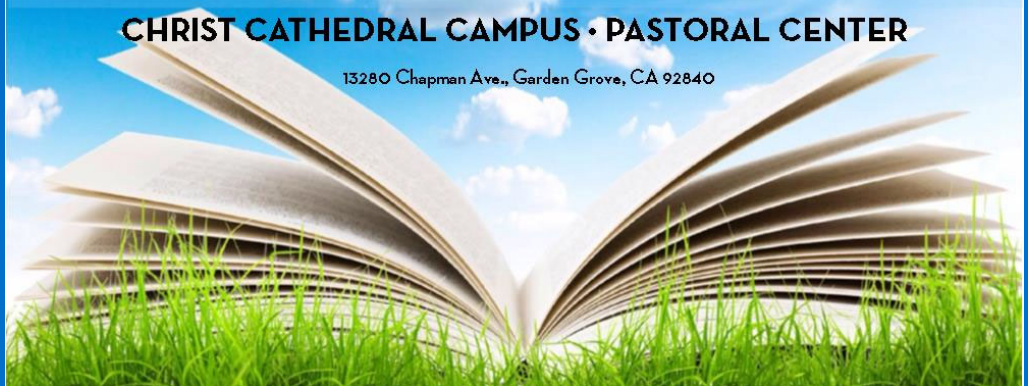

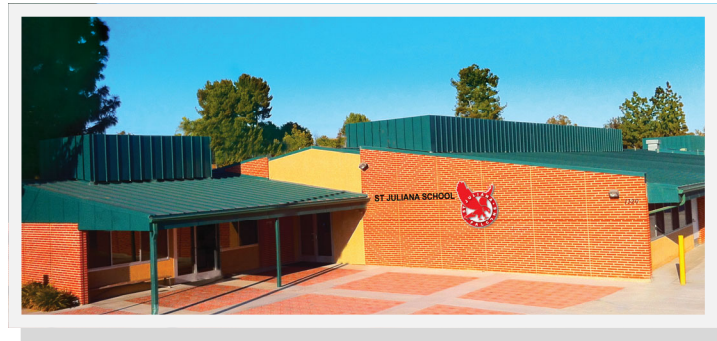
