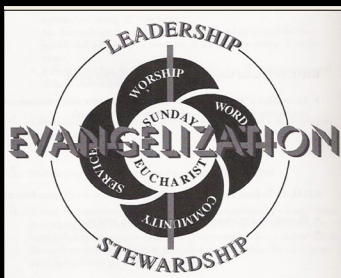

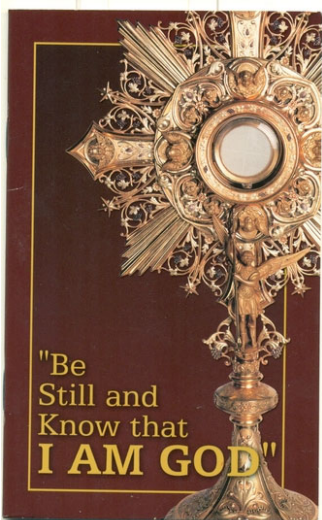
Marriage class continued, Lesson V.

At the dinner table Fr. Brown told Fr. Guy of his appointment with Joseph and Mary. Fr. Guy felt sorry as Fr. Brown spoke of the difficulties he experienced with the couple. Then Fr. Guy related to Fr. Brown that one of his couples, Aldo and Lena, came in earlier during the day for their final appointment. Fr. Guy was most delighted! He is happy with the couple who will be married in Mass in two weeks.

The Engaged Encounter was not at the top of the list of things Aldo and Lena needed to do. They did schedule and complete the weekend retreat. When asked how it went, their response was the usual: "It was good." Fr. Guy asked directly: "I'm happy, can you explain a little more? What made it 'good'?" They told him it encouraged them to grow as a couple, it directed them to connect with each other and to realize for the first time what "getting married in the Church as a sacrament, an encounter with Jesus" means not just on paper but in life. They enjoyed the interaction with other engaged couples. Actually they made new friends, people in the same boat! Since they got serious, they didn't become fundamentalists or weird, but they did start attending Mass with greater regularity. They started to pray with and for each other which they hadn't done before the Engaged Encounter. With a bit of laughter, Aldo recalled that his maternal grandmother, Antoinette, was the one who really taught him to pray. His "Nonna" had a crucifix low on the wall in the entry of the house. She taught everyone, family at least, who came into the house to bless themselves and to do the same as they left. "Nonna taught us all to pray often and for everyone," said Aldo. During this conversation, Lena told Aldo that his Nonna's crucifix was low on the wall because Nonna was so short. We all laughed! The point was made that they both were taught to pray, yet they let that practice to dwindle as they grew older. The Encounter re-kindled the practice of prayer and a religious presence in their lives. Fr. Guy told Fr. Brown that Aldo and Lena said: "Fr. Guy, thank you for helping us. The Encounter and talks with you also encouraged greater discussion of finances and family matters. Fr. Guy, we really feel differently about being married now than we did eight months ago when we first met you. We could have gotten married on Balboa Island, or in Lena's back yard, instead we are getting married in St. Dismas and in a Mass."

Lena told Fr. Guy the readings they had chosen and why they picked the ones they did. That "love is patient sort of poem" has always been a favorite of hers. Aldo wanted the "wives be submissive to your husband" reading. Not really, he was just being Aldo! Fr. Guy carried on about how Pope Francis has just written about First Corinthians chapter 12-13 in his Apostolic Exhortation, *Amoris Laetitia - The Joy of Love*. He asked them to do a "Google search" for the document and read it, but after the wedding because he intended to "use" some of it in his homily.

They reviewed the whole ceremony. Fr. Guy wanted to be sure the couple knew what was going to happen and why. He asked if they wanted anything that was not mentioned. Fr. Guy told them to be sure the photographers and florists observe the rules of St. Dismas Parish. They have arranged their rehearsal with the parish wedding coordinator, Mrs. Wright and cleared all music with Mrs. Fitzgerald. Fr. Guy intends to be at the rehearsal and attend the rehearsal dinner.



Plan to spend prayer time on Tuesday, August 2, during Solemn Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. It happens the first Tuesday of each month. Prayer, always but especially before the Blessed Sacrament Exposed, will fill us with love for God and a deeper relationship with Jesus. Jesus structured his day with prayer times. Those are the times he turned to God for energy. His encounter with God in prayer gave him the wisdom and strength he needed to handle the world's needs easier. Shouldn't each of us do the same? Prayer before the Blessed Sacrament Exposed will fill us with awe and wonder – the same way that beauty and love leaves those who encounter them speechless. Allow Jesus to reveal himself to you, charge you with His energy, and fill you with new life so that you can go and be Brothers and Sisters of such a wonderful and great Son of God. It is my hope that our parish will imitate our patroness, St. Juliana, with true love and devotion to the Blessed Sacrament and knowledge of our faith so that we can become what we say we are – Catholic Christians whose address is St. Juliana Falconieri Parish, Fullerton, California. Perhaps you can begin or continue this prayer as a family tradition. Perhaps you can sacrifice some time and be quiet with the Lord in the quiet hours from mid-night to 6AM.

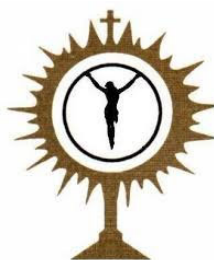

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

(RCIA), is a process developed by the Catholic Church for prospective converts to Catholicism who are above the age of infant baptism. Candidates are gradually introduced to aspects of Catholic beliefs and practices.

For those who join a RCIA process it is a period of reflection, prayer, instruction, discernment, and formation. There is no set timetable and those who join the process are encouraged to go at their own pace, taking as much time as they need.

Those who enter the process are expected to begin attending Mass on Sunday, attend a weekly RCIA session, and become increasingly involved in the activities of their local parish.
