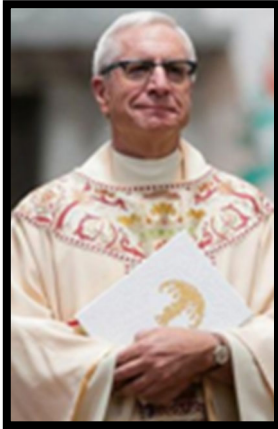

## ~ A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M. ~



Marriage continued; part II.

Joseph and Mary grow from anonymity to friendship. From not know each other to dating. They talk with each other, share meals especially spaghetti on Sundays, go to movies, the beach, ball games, and Disneyland. As their relationship matures, they grow in love and self-giving. Over time, they form an ever deepening relationship that is significant. Joseph and Mary become a couple. Joseph and Mary are “meant for each other” and this becomes clear to them. Families meet each other.

It takes Joseph just a bit longer. Ah, sweet mystery of life, at last I have found thee! He buys a special ring. He plans a special occasion. He asks “the question!” It’s the Fourth of July! Fireworks all around! Mary says: “Yes! I will!” More fireworks. Champagne! Pictures! Memories! 500 Facebook “likes.”

Joseph and Mary are both Roman Catholics. Or not. One is but not the other. Mary has always known and planned where and how she would be married. Joseph just wants to get married! Mary, of course, wins. From engagement to wedding day, Joseph only needs to know one sentence: “Yes, Dear!” Mary insists on a wedding in the Roman Catholic Church. Off to the church offices they go!

They make an appointment with the kind priest. At the first appointment he asks: “Now, why are we here, together at this time?” Joseph responds: “We want to get married.” Fr. Brown looks at him and asks: “Why?” Joe responds: “I want to start a family.” Fr. Brown: “That’s nice, now why do you want to get married?” Joe continues: “We would like to have kids.” Fr. Brown: “Good, why get married?” Joseph: “Because it’s the right thing to do.” Fr. Brown: “Yes, it is, you’ve not always done the right thing. Why get married?” Joe volleys back: “I want to buy a home.” Fr. Brown: “Many are for sale. Why do you want to get married?” Joe now realizes that Fr. Brown must be looking for a specific answer. He turns to Mary and shrugs his shoulders. Mary can’t hold back: “Fr. Brown, we came to you because we want to get married. We want to get married because we love each other.” Fr. Brown breathes calmly: “Yes, that is the answer! Good, now let us continue.”

Yes, they want to get married because they love each other. And for no other reason. Joseph proposed to Mary because he loves her. And for no other reason. The time of engagement; from proposal to wedding day should be a time to begin a serious commitment to grow in love and self-giving. Romance and infatuation and physical attraction all turn to the beginning of love.

In reality, marriage preparation began with life in our own family. We learn what Christian marriage is all about and how to live it from our families. Learning to love “until death do us part” does not happen with a pre-marriage course or from the book, *Love for Dummies*.

Fr. Brown will give some council to the couple. Memorizing passages from the Catechism is not as important as is the interior preparation for a live long and life giving relationship with each other. Mary and Joseph will still need to grow in friendship and love. They will learn how to encounter Jesus Christ and how their marriage will reflect His presence as they live together as a couple. It is true and it is sad that couples marry without really knowing one another or allowing Jesus a place in their relationship.

The couple, Fr. Brown, and the parish secretary will set the date for the marriage ceremony. The couple will be asked to get a newly issued copy of their registered Roman Catholic baptism from the church where each was baptized. If only one is baptized, that will be all right. A separate document has to be prepared and sent to the Catholic bishop’s office and that is easy. The couple will be asked to complete an “engaged encounter” seminar. Fr. Brown will want to meet with the couple a few more times.

Most important during their engagement is that Mary and Joseph continue to take time and really know each other and how each one responds to and weathers the various cycles of life. They must learn how to give and to accept compliments. “Honey, I didn’t know you had it in you!” is not a compliment! They need to learn how to express and respond to the “negative emotions” of anger, fear, and sadness. Plan how to save and spend money, free time, and the sharing of friends. When their love is strong, plan for children. The intention of their marriage is that they live together “until death do us part.” Although the usual recessional music piece is called “The Wedding March” they are not going off to battle!

Separate topic: Summer time is for travel and spontaneity! Enjoy the life God has given you, especially as a family to get away and enjoy each other. The unexpected ball game or trip is not to be missed. If you have scheduled Sunday liturgical commitments such as altar serving, lecturing, ministry of the Eucharist, or Usher/hospitality – and are not able to fulfill your ministry – please arrange for a substitute. Thank you so much for all you do at St. Juliana! We can’t do it without you!

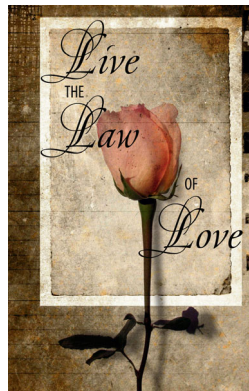

**JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY**

**July 10, 2016**

**Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Could anyone object to Jesus' supreme lesson in mercy, the parable of the Good Samaritan? Jesus' devoutly religious audience certainly did! *Scant sympathy* for anyone foolish enough to travel crime-ridden "Jericho Highway" alone. *Much sympathy* for priest and Levite, hurrying to assigned temple ministry, unwilling to risk ritual impurity through hands-on mercy. *No sympathy* for Jesus' scandalous hero. Samaritans were religious apostates and political enemies. Jesus challenges them—and us—to seek God's presence not only in liturgical beauty but in a fellow traveler's self-inflicted misfortunes. See God's presence even in someone outside the law, whose hands-on mercy springs not from religious obligation but from the heart's instinctive goodness. Since Jesus became our "Good Samaritan" despite our foolishness and sins, who are we to ration our mercy? "Who is my neighbor?" (Luke 10:29). The next person we see who needs hands-on mercy! No conditions, no limits, no exceptions. Especially in this *Jubilee Year of Mercy*, Jesus commands, "Go and do likewise" (10:37).

**RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA) - SESSIONS BEGIN IN AUGUST**

For adults today, the Church, after the Second Vatican Council, has restored the order of the Catechumenate in the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults*(RCIA). It outlines the steps for the formation of catechumens (non-baptized persons), bringing their conversion to the faith to a greater maturity. It helps them respond more deeply to **God's gracious initiative in their lives and prepares them for union with the Church community**. This process is meant to form them into the fullness of the Christian life and to become disciples of Jesus, their teacher. This includes an initiation into the mystery of salvation, the practice of faith, hope, and love, and other virtues in a succession of liturgical rites.

Persons baptized into another Christian church and now seeking full communion with the Catholic Church are also welcomed to participate along with catechumens in the RCIA in the process of learning about the Catholic faith and being formed in that faith. They bring to the process of preparation their prior experience of Christian life and prayer. For a baptized Christian, reception into full communion with the Catholic Church involves reception of the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation and then a Profession of Faith followed by the celebration of Confirmation and the Eucharist.

If you or someone you love is not baptized or baptized in another Christian faith and seek full communion with the Roman Catholic Church we look forward to talking with you and assisting in your discernment. Contact the Parish Office at 714-879-1965 to speak with the RCIA Team.

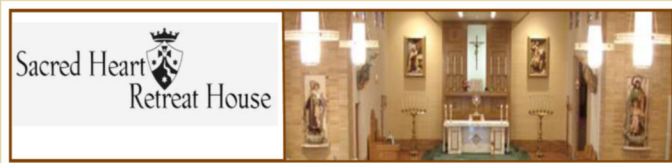

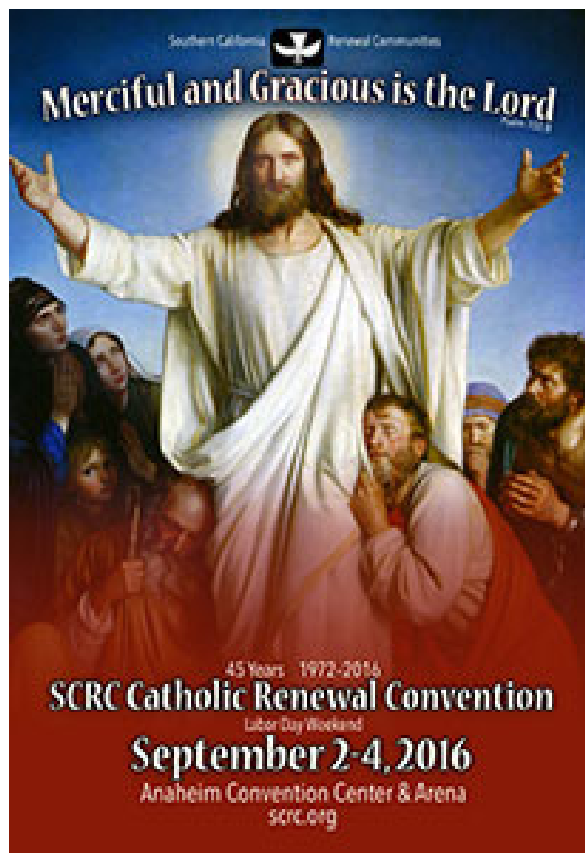

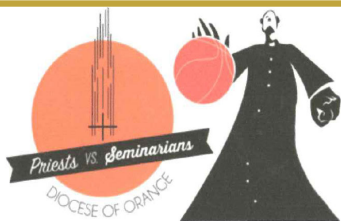
