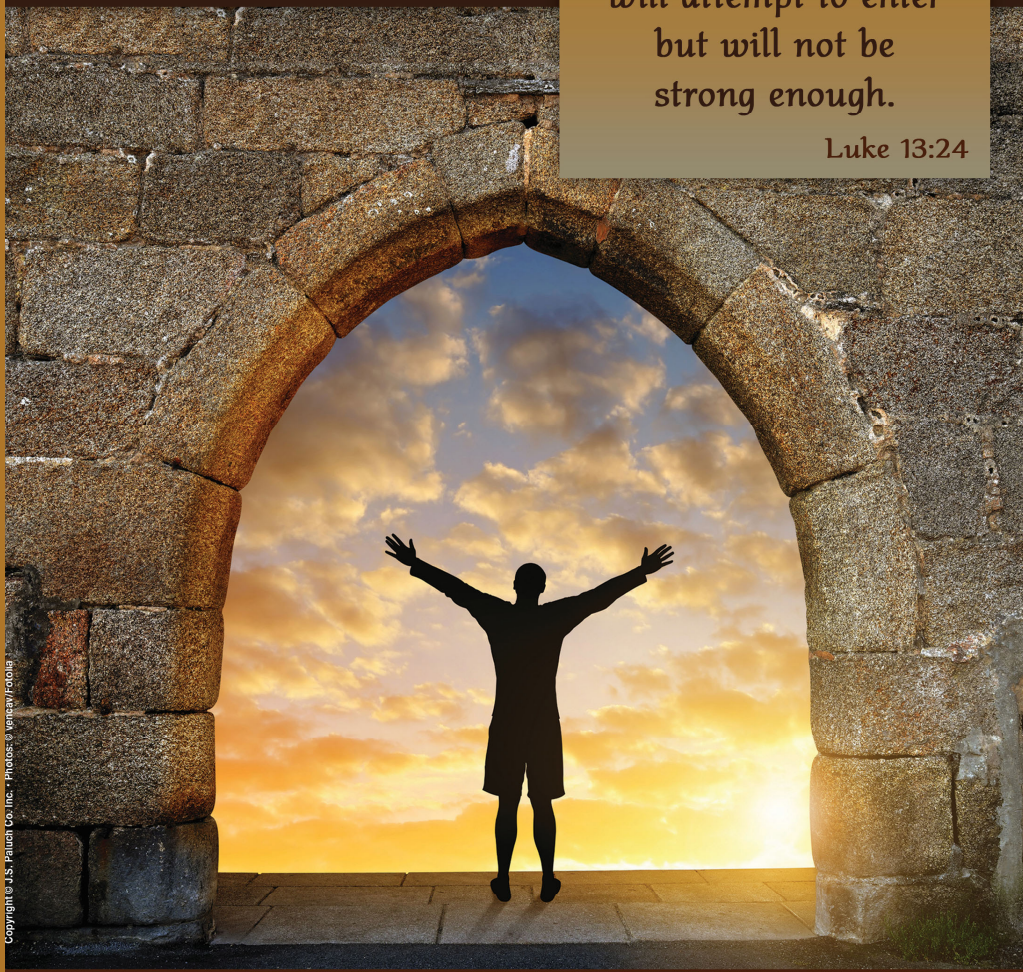

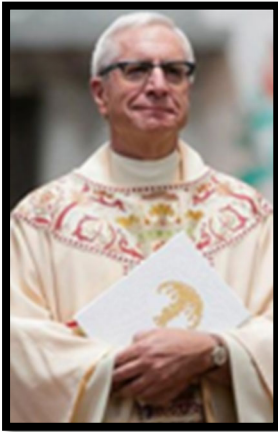

## ~ A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M. ~



Marriage Class continued, Lesson VII

Sidney Robinowitz and Margret Mary Radcliffe have known each other since they were high school students at Holy Rosary High School. Sid and Maggie had many classes together, however it was during their senior year when Sid played varsity basketball and Maggie was the head spirit girl for the “Mysteries” –as their team was called - that their relationship went from anonymity to friendship. Together they were in the school play. They both matriculated to Literati University where they majored in theatre; she was a leading lady and he the male star. In time, they complemented each other on and off the stage, together they were complete! Sid thought: “Ah, sweet mystery of life at last I found thee!” One night, after a final curtain, Sid asked Margret to be his wife. The Robinowitz family is Jewish, the Radcliffes are Roman Catholics. Both families accept the relationship and recognize its nature as “mixed religion.”

Can they marry in the Roman Church? Yes!

Between Roman Catholics and other Christians, a spirit of good will and ecumenical relations exists. We have made great progress since the days when the Radcliffes might have looked at Sid as if he had hooves and a tail. The same could be true if Margret brought home Martin Crossley from Prince Lutheran Community. The difference is the Christian (Lutheran or other baptized Christian) and the non-Christian (Jewish, Hindu, Muslim or not Christian) person. There is some pastoral concern with religion: Which will be practiced? With the ceremony: Liturgy of the Word or full Mass? And faith of the children.

Do not allow the “disparity of worship or cult” prohibit you from consulting a priest or deacon regarding being married in the Roman Catholic Church.

John Paul Elliot is engaged to Patricia Anne White, they are two Roman Catholics. She wants to be married outdoors, in fact in the Peristyle entrance to the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum with a reception in the Rose Garden. Don’t begin to plan it without permission from the bishop! Usually such permission is not granted. While beautiful outdoor or hotel \ Country Club \ backyard \ Presidential Library, and etc. settings are available, they do have their distractions including the sun and elements of weather, drinks and food, airplanes, and etc. The informal setting is simply not controllable and not as prayerful or sacred as the Sacrament of Matrimony necessitates.

Donald Blair is a Roman Catholic who is now divorced. He was married in Las Vegas but the marriage was never “blessed” in any way by a priest or any Christian minister. He wants to marry a Catholic widow, Angie Ricci. The priest or deacon will help with the proper “Lack of Form” papers, an easy process. Pastoral preparation for the marriage can begin after the Lack of Form process is completed.

## JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY

August 21, 2016

## Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

This *Jubilee Year of Mercy* and Pope Francis' ministry have renewed our understanding that the Church's heart is open wide to all, and the heart of the gospel is God's mercy. Flooded with God's mercy, our hearts should overflow as channels bringing to wounded and weary hearts Jesus' healing mercy. For Jesus warns, our own salvation is not guaranteed by the Liturgy of the Word ("you taught in our streets") nor by the Eucharist ("we ate and drank in your company") (Luke 13:26). People far from that banquet, "from the east and the west and from the north and the south . . . will recline at table in the kingdom of God" (13:29). Rather, showing mercy is key to obtaining mercy ourselves (Matthew 5:7). So we should never dare ask what "someone" asked Jesus, "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" (Luke 13:23). The crucial question is "Will I be saved?" And Jesus' answer is another question: "Have you shown mercy to everyone, freely, gladly, no limits, no conditions, no exceptions?"

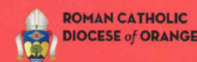
