




Page Three ~ A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M. ~ September 18, 2016

September 14th was the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross - many of us may have called it simply, The Feast of the Holy Cross. It is always important to remember that the Cross of Christ is the celebration of the salvation Jesus won for us; being righteous before God – our sins are forgiven AND the promise of eternity - with death, life is changed not ended.

The Cross means Jesus was executed; it was the life sentence for a criminal. It means suffering, not a quick or easy way to die. Usual punishment was cruel and public punishment.

The Cross of Christ is not simply a piece of jewelry, it does not simply mean: "Christians are nearby." The Cross is the suffering of Jesus that leads to the death of Jesus. The Cross of Christ is the means to our salvation. "Remember the works of the Lord" when you wear or see a cross.

So, notice the Cross. Really pray with the cross. See the intersection of the long vertical bar and the shorter horizontal bar; notice heaven meeting earth close to the head of Jesus. See the man all used up. The man is all used up because he loves us so much. "For God so loved the world that he sent His only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life."




September 15th was the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows. The Seven Sorrows of The Blessed Virgin Mary are: 1. The Prophecy of Simeon, 2. The flight into Egypt, 3. The loss of the Child Jesus in the temple, 4. The meeting of Jesus and Mary on the Way of the Cross, 5. The Crucifixion, 6. The taking down of the Body of Jesus from the Cross, 7. The burial of Jesus.

Mary, the Mother of the Lord, stood in each of these stations with her "heart pierced." Can you imagine the questions, the pondering, the soul searching for meaning that being the Mother of Jesus must have meant?

As you sat with the cross, now sit and reflect on each of these stations. Imagine being told by Simeon, a true holy man, that your heart will be pierced. Imagine that you must leave your home with a new born because there is life-threating danger to your child; you might have a statue of this image in your home. Ponder losing

your child in a crowd. Now, ponder losing the Savior of the world in a crowd! Can you meet your son as he carries a real cross on his way to his execution? See the crucifixion as the Mother of Jesus. You are standing there, with few others. For station six, find the image of the Pieta of Michelangelo. This time it is not only a superb work of art but a real scene; a mother holding her dead child. Finally, sit with the image of the horrible agony of burying your child.



CATECHETICAL SUNDAY - September 18th

The word catechesis comes from the Greek meaning "to echo the teaching...people in communion with Jesus Christ."

Together, let us pray for all catechists—those who are called to the ministry of teaching our faith.






