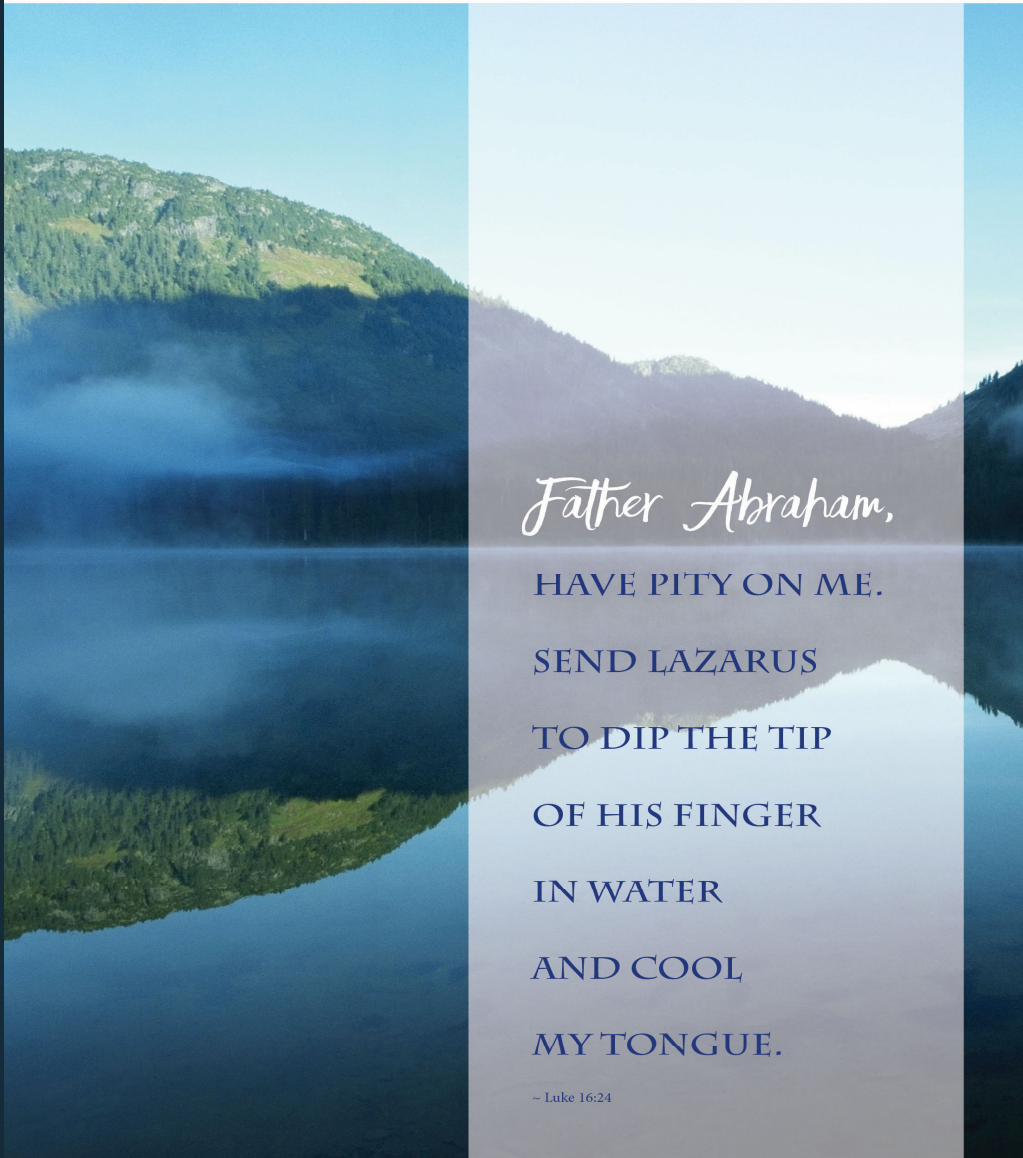

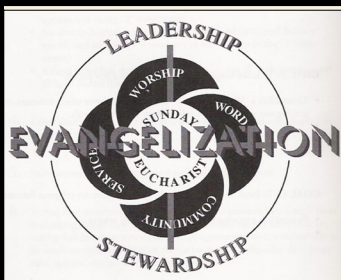

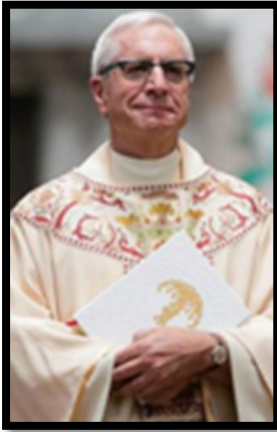

Holy Orders continued.

The sacrament of Holy Orders is received only once. That makes it like baptism and confirmation. It allows priests to offer Mass, administer absolution, and anoint. In a technical way, when marriage takes place in a Mass, priests “preside” and deacons “assist.”

Associated with Holy Orders is the thorny issue (problem) of authority; especially authority over the laity and within the ranks of orders itself, a bishop’s authority is over other clergy. Issues are raised regarding power and jurisdiction. You see, as one is ordained, that man is set apart from the other members of the Faithful because of his distinct “order” in the community. One day he is one of the crowds sitting in pews, from ordination ceremony on, he is transformed by “power and grace.” More importantly, and a lot more subtly, this rank and its power raises questions about the nature of church, a branch of theology called “ecclesiology.” Let’s leave this topic for another time!

Any power the deacon, priest, or bishop has comes from ordination and ordination comes in the form of the imposition of hands and prayer. Bishops ordain bishops because they have that power; the completeness of “orders.” Bishops ordain priests and deacons. The holiness of the office is passed on by the laying on of hands and prayer. The hands of the bishop are placed in a prayerful manner on the head of the man being ordained.

Again, if you wish to know what the Church believes, listen to Her prayer: “Hear us, Lord our God, and pour out upon this servant of yours the blessing of the Holy Spirit and the grace and power of the priesthood. In your sight we offer this man for ordination: support him with your unfailing love.” Following this prayer, the candidate for ordination kneels before the bishop. This bishop and all priests present lay hands on the candidate’s head, in silence.

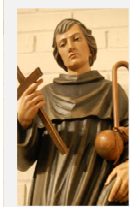

JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY

September 25, 2016
Twenty-sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time
Jubilee for Catechists

Amos castigates religious people who, “comfortably complacent” (6:1, 5), ignore the unfolding collapse of culture, nation, religion (6:6). In Jesus’ parable, such complacency becomes the rich man’s undoing. He neither hurt nor harmed Lazarus, neither denied him leftovers nor ordered him removed. That is Jesus’ devastating point. The rich man did nothing wrong to Lazarus; he just did nothing at all good for him. Only in death, separated by “a great chasm” (Luke 16:26), could the rich man finally see Lazarus, whom he had failed to see in life, right before his eyes. Like the rich man’s “five brothers still in my father’s house” (16:27-28), we who are alive in the Church still have time to see that same Someone, Jesus, lying neglected right at our door—and time to do something. Who, specifically, concretely, practically, is Lazarus in my life? What can I do for that Jesus-in-the-flesh during this *Jubilee Year of Mercy*?
