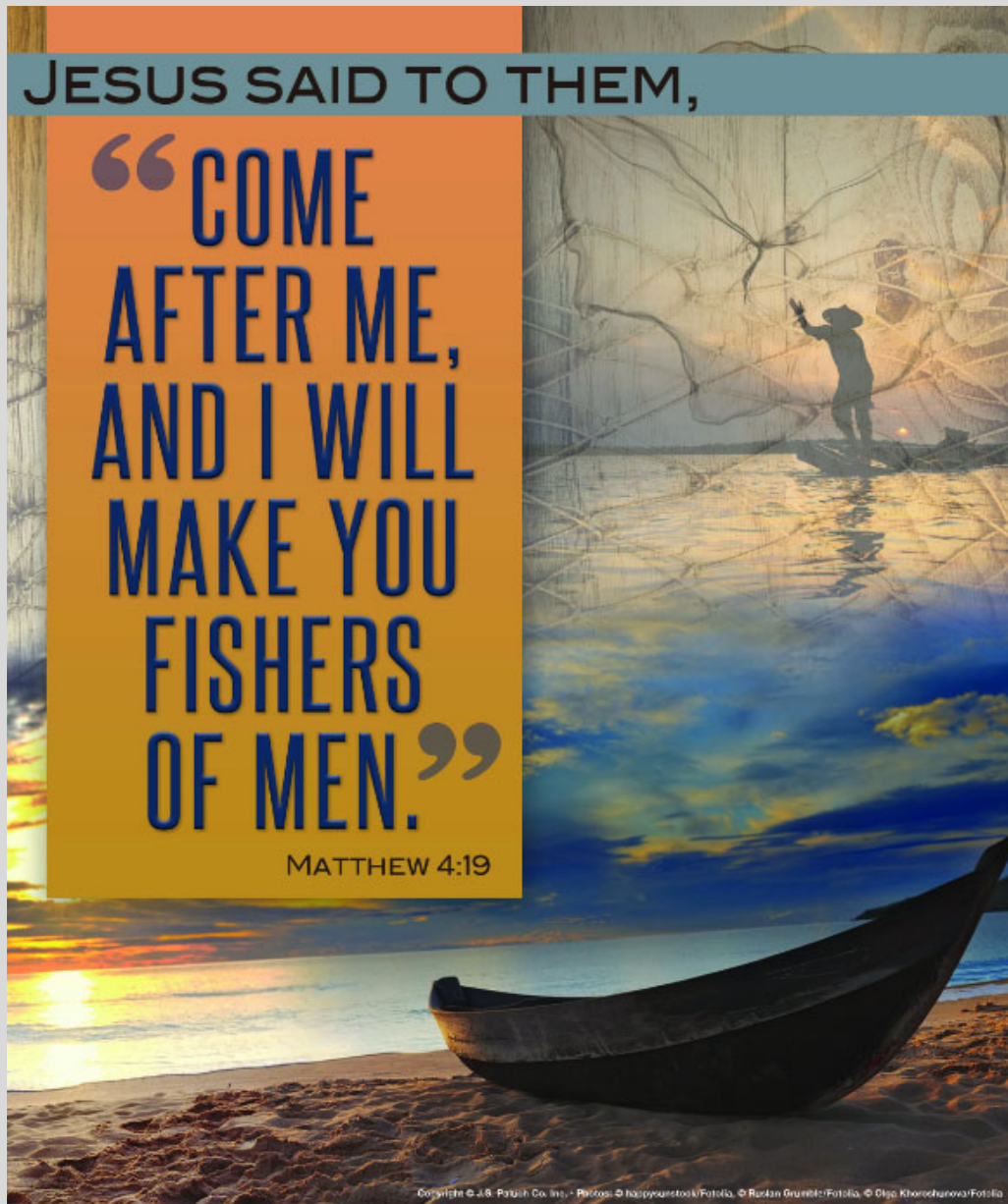

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

I'm no minimalist; I struggle to possess and then get rid of stuff. I like things that decorate a room; I enjoy a room with a few really nice things and not much more. I could live in a monastery; I would be happy in Versailles. Years ago a friend sent me a cartoon from the New Yorker Magazine which I had already seen and laughed a loud at. A man was kneeling at his bedside praying: "I don't ask for much, but what I get should be of very good quality." Good friends know each other!

If you want to be radical, get to the root of what you are to do and do that. Ask and answer around your dinner table: "What are the radical goals of the American Dream? What are the radical goals of pop culture?" Then ask: "What are the ideals of the American Dream and pop culture today?" When the time is right, turn to a "forbidden topic" - religion - for a discussion that might be really heated ask: "What is the Christian ideal?" and "What is the Roman Catholic ideal?" What are the

root truths, those fundamental principles that are non-negotiable without which you could never call yourself an authentic Christian or Roman Catholic? Mind you, you could be a most wonderful person, even an atheist, but not a Christian. So, "be helpful, tell the truth, hands off - don't steal or even touch" really does not answer the question. You hope that your neighbor, co-worker, and fellow student of what-ever religion or even non-believer in any God will abide by the rules that keep any tribe together. What makes a good Christian and further a good Roman Catholic different from a Boy or Girl Scout? Let's not ask for much, but let the stuff of the answer be "really good quality."

Ought we agree on at least: "Jesus is the embodiment of God. Jesus died in order to rise from the dead and share immortality with us. If you want to be part of the community of Jesus you need conversion, that is 180° from the goals of anything that is of a Me First or What will make ME happy attitude to the attitude of Jesus 'love and serve others as I loved and served others' - it's all about the Kingdom of God and love/serve God and neighbor, and finally we must participate at every opportunity available to us with the community of believers - the Church and the Eucharist - a special meal Jesus left us, to remember him and nourish us."

If you believe the Gospels it is obvious that Jesus had enemies. His enemies had strong resentment. They put him to death not for being a nice guy but for being a rabble rouser. How you answer this next question will give the whole Church community direction: "If Jesus' enemies could come together for a common purpose, how much more should his friends try to overcome their differences and work together for his purposes?"

You might say that Jesus' purpose is reconciliation. By his death and resurrection, he has reconciled us to God and brought us together as one family, the Church. This is why divisions among his people—Catholic, Orthodox, or Protestant—strike him so deeply in the heart. The ideal is that Christ divinizes our lives in such a way that we are challenged to serve and worship together. Divisions should fall into perspective and we are best when we are not bogged down by secondary issues.

A Week of Prayer for Christian Unity began last Wednesday. It is important that we call that to mind because this year marks the five hundredth anniversary of the Protestant Reformation. At the same time, however, this anniversary is taking place in an "ecumenical age" of remarkable progress toward unity. Approach this anniversary highlighting all that we have in common rather than the issues that still divide us. If we can work together in friendship and belief in Jesus despite our theological differences, we can bear witness to the love of Jesus and break down walls of division. In all that we do in the name of Christianity and Jesus' voice: "That they may all be one...that the world may believe" (John 17.21) be heard?
