

THE PARISH AS ONE BODY



A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

HELP! I need your help! Help! We all need the help you can offer! Help! We all need the help your family can give us! Help! We all need the help your ministry, your Small Christian Community, your parish organization, you and others like you can give us! Help! Please help! This parish needs your help for a full twenty four hours on the First Tuesday of each month.

Believe that the voice of Jesus is calling you, just like he called his original disciples! Jesus didn't just happen a long time ago in a faraway place. He is alive today! He is saying: "Come to me! Come to me you look tired because you are tired. Come to me! Let me speak to you. Come to me! Tell me what is going on with you; we haven't shared quality time lately! Come to me, let me energize you! Come to me, you are precious and you are mine! I am here and I am with you! Learn from me so you can make a difference! Come to me! Come to me!"

If you want to experience something really beautiful, come and see the Lord of our Life in the Holy Eucharist. Christian faith is the experience of God as God is revealed in Jesus Christ. Come experience Jesus Christ. Pray with Jesus so you can know him, know him to deepen a relationship with him, deepen your friendship you will be converted, and converted you will live your faith as his friend.

Love is a commitment to spend time with another. May I lead you to make a commitment to spend time with Our Savior?

I hope WE made a commitment – that on the first Tuesday of each month we, the Eucharistic Parish of St. Juliana Falconieri, would expose the Blessed Sacrament to pray, adore, meet, and love Jesus who is present to us in a most special way as the Holy Sacrament of His Presence.

When I first came to you, I was asked that the church be "kept open with the lights on." The last thing our cleaning crew does at night is to turn off the lights and lock the doors. People going into the church during the day are a joyful sight. Really, you imitate Jesus who "went to a deserted place to pray." The grace of your visit … WOW! With the university, two high schools, and being in the center of a residential community among a population of blessings and challenges, I would like to keep the church open around the clock. For those who do come I hope the open door, a hotline to call, or an encounter with another Christian makes a difference.

HELP! What started last Lent is struggling now. I don't want to stop First Tuesday Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament because we can't do it. St. Juliana herself had a great devotion to the Holy Eucharist, let's imitate our saint and pray before Jesus with her. If you are able to, please sign up for a time from after the 8:00AM Mass on the first Tuesday until just before the 6:30AM Mass the next (Wednesday) morning. It will cost you one hour – more or less – of one day a month. (Exposition and adoration are the same. The Blessed Sacrament is taken from the tabernacle and exposed in the monstrance so you may pray in adoration with Jesus present before you.)


Come with a group, come with your family – please make time and come. Start a good habit that will be faith-life giving. Bring a Bible, spiritual book, or religious song on your private ear-buds. Please visit the Blessed Sacrament, the Holy Eucharist the

Real Presence of Jesus on our parish day; a full twenty-four hours of Exposition - please come! Make it a habit, let the habit make a difference.




