A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Reflect on these lessons from today's readings once more: "Behold our God, to whom we looked to save us! This is the Lord for whom we looked; let us rejoice and be glad that he has saved us." "I shall live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life." "My God will fully supply whatever you need, in accord with his glorious riches in Christ Jesus. To our God and Father, glory forever and ever. Amen." "Behold, I have prepared my banquet, my calves and fatted cattle are killed, and everything is ready; come to the feast." Read that Truth, reflect on that Truth, believe that Truth, live that Truth.

Why would anyone who is baptized, and at least put down a tap root and one stem, NOT want to pause and say a prayer to God – if not come to Mass? What would keep anyone from a feast prepared by the Lord who saves us? What takes folks away from a relationship with God and worship of Him who gives us life? Why take any option, consider all distractions – sports play or spectate, education, shop buy or window shop, physical but not spiritual exercise? How do you practice the first three commandments?

I guess a lot of folks never really grew a tap root and even one strong stem. Re-read the parable of the seeds; the farmer went off and threw seeds extravagantly, carelessly. Some seed grew other seed didn't. Some baptized and educated Catholics have formed a real life-giving and life-long relationship with God others have not grown so strong for so long. Financial investments and growth were monitored more closely than faith investments and spiritual growth. Membership with the AAA is paid for in case it is needed, is the Community called Church also important?

Talk to God who is our Father, relate to Jesus our brother. Prayerfully reflect on Scripture. A lot of Bibles are bought and downloaded – is the Word of God read, known, believed and lived? Encounter God in other people and reflect Jesus and his command to love one another – the work of holding a door open, smiling, welcoming someone into our church building and community. Craft a prayer – your own words to God. Begin each day by thanking God for the gift of life and each day examining your conscience; are you kept aware of God's presence, do you fulfill his will, ask for what you need, and forgive others who wronged you during the day? Do you pray and live the Our Father or simply recite the Lord's Prayer?

Each of us has the gift of life. We are saved by the Grace of God – AMAZING! We need the gift of salvation, won for us by the Cross of Christ. The heart of our faith is the Sacred Heart of Jesus. What are the deepest desires of your heart as you live your faith?

We long to live in one place, the house of God. Are you in God's house often enough or might you be found elsewhere even and especially during the hours of Mass or Eucharistic Exposition?

Catholic identity is that attitude that shapes us and shows others how we Catholics respond to God's love for us. It's a spiritual matter that is shown by the way we leave Mass to "proclaim the Good News by the way we live our lives."

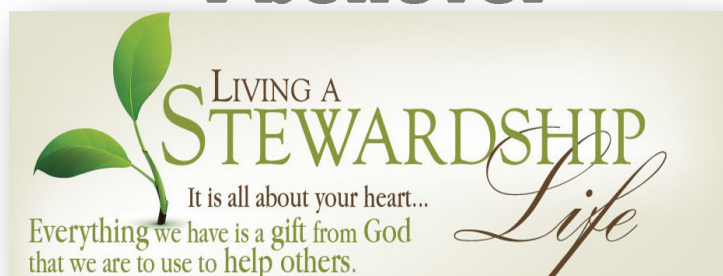
How do you show others that you believe that Jesus is the Lord who saves us? It's the identity you have, the center that holds everything together. It's better than the way you show others that you belong to the Automobile Club when your car won't start.

Right?
