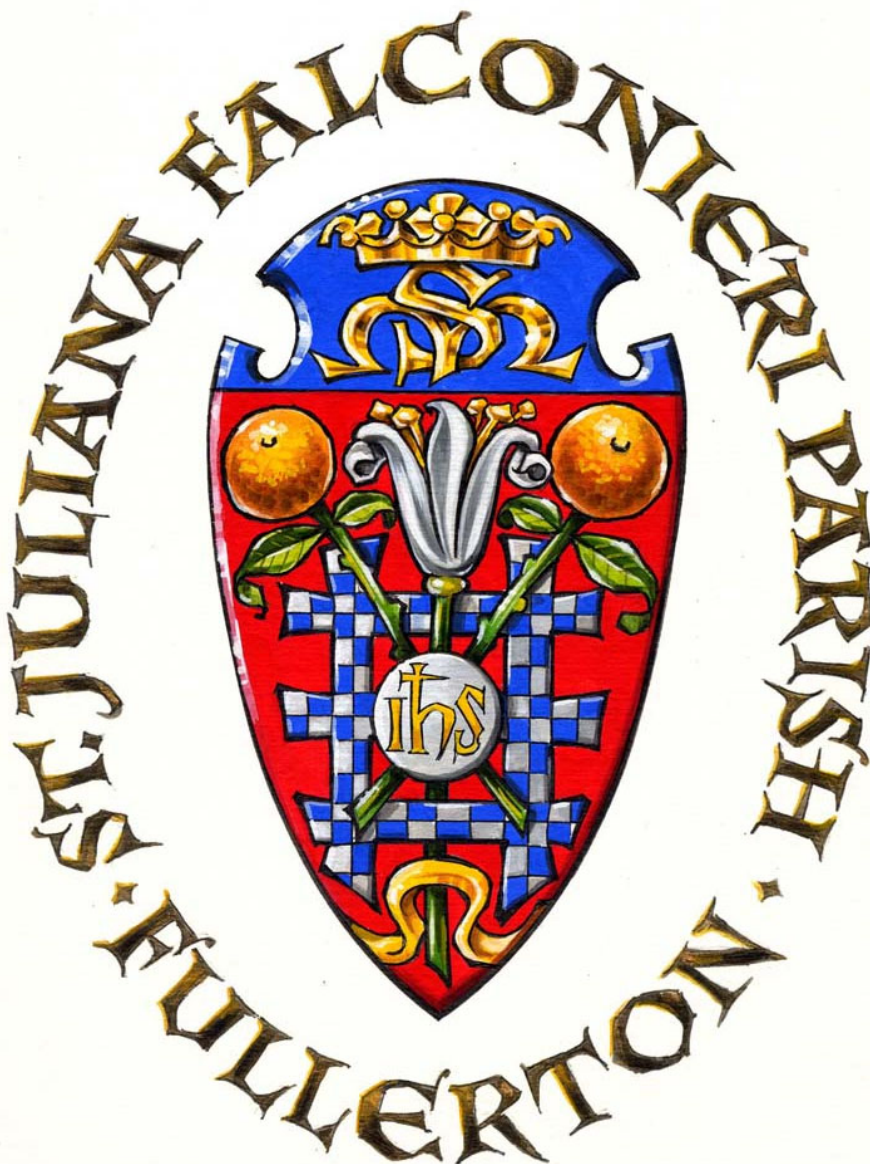

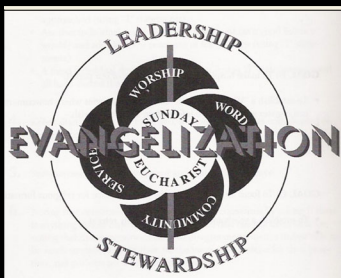

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Our Gospel lesson today, as it has been for the past several weeks, is a selection from the Sermon on the Mount. In this sermon taken from St. Matthew Jesus poses the ideal, a motivating goal that helps each of us in our faith journey toward our Heavenly Father. Remember, no one before or after Jesus and Mary ever attained such an ideal except for some fleeting moments. Even the saints! A priest who served as an effective spiritual director taught me: “Michael, saints are, for the most part, ordinary people whose biographies have been edited greatly!” Strive for the goal.

Jesus is directing us to the North Star. Indulge yourself once in a while. The real question is what’s more important; comfort or character?

Lent begins this coming Wednesday, March 1. This Lent, practice mercy, practice virtue. Become a person of sound Christian character, turning away from the things of the world, learn to live for the Lord. Become a person of Christian character by your resolve this Lent.

The Year of Mercy is ended, has mercy ended? Of course not! Is mercy practiced in your life, in the life of the communities you belong to?

Turn from vice and learn and practice Christian virtue. “Everyone knows” – a most dangerous expression – what not to do. We all know vice and deadly sins. This Lent, learn and practice the correcting virtue. Turn from “Me first”, “look at me” pride and practice humility. Not “I am nothing false humility” but learn Christian humility and practice it. Turn from envy: “You always get the better, I get the worse, darn (or worse) you.” Learn and practice Christian admiration. Turn away from anger. Learn and practice Christian forgiveness. Turn from lazy, not really lazy but un-motivated sloth. Learn and practice Christian zeal. Turn from avarice, “I need this and these things to make me happy.” Learn and practice Christian generosity. Rid yourself of gluttony: “I love especially good food and fine drink.” Learn and practice Christian asceticism. Notice and avoid lust in your life. Learn and practice Christian chastity.

Notice the adjective CHRISTIAN. All people should avoid what is wrong and practice right moral/ethical actions. The Christian acts in such a way as to imitate the actions of Jesus our Teacher. It’s a matter of What Would Jesus Do! How ought I to act since I follow Jesus? That is Christian Character.

Where is Jesus leading us? Jesus leads us to his Heavenly Father. That journey will make all the difference in your life and in our life as the St. Juliana Catholic Community

This Lent:

Turn to acts of mercy. Learn and practice them.

Turn from vice and sin. Learn and practice good Christian virtue.

The Sermon on the Mount presents the ideal. Strive to reach the goal. Missing the mark is called sin. Remember all the good things you do and rely on God’s grace to guide you to goodness, happiness, and holiness.

Ash Wednesday is a day of Fast and Abstinence

The website of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops – USCCB.ORG – is the site for accurate information about our Catholic Church in the United States. Copied from that site is the following regulation regarding Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays of Lent and our diet:

“Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.”

Lent is not only about dietary laws! It is about the reforming of life and the returning to the Gospel.
