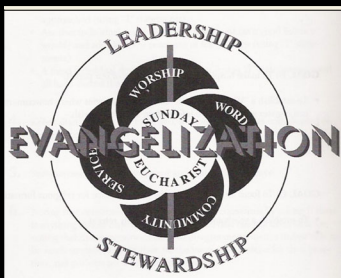

## A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Do Scripture readings challenge you? Pssst: They ought to. If they don't challenge you, perhaps you aren't really reading Scripture. Today's lessons, all three challenge each one of us to rise up and proclaim: "Yes! I have gifts and I will use them as a good disciple to make Jesus known. Yes, I have a light and I'm gonna let it shine."

Who, me? Yes, you. Me? "Salt of the earth?" Me, "Light for the world?" Yes, you. Us, a "city on a mountain?" Yes, we are a city on the hill. Just look at the city from our hill.

But I am a nobody. I've come from a village of nobodies. Don't expect much from us.

NONSENSE!

We are the Lord's. We are his baptized brothers and sisters. We belong to his family. By that measure, we are a community of somebodies.

You have gifts, many of them. Not just one to bury. Gifts of grace to make the many communities you belong to flourish. Gifts to be used for the glory of God. Your family, your school, your teams, your business, your church, your committees and your ministries are made better when, with courage, you are God's presence in them.

Really, can we get serious here? You know, I might be brave but I caution against foolhardiness.

It's amazing what God has done and continues to do with His people.

Real courage isn't being noticed, like riding a motor-cycle across the Grand Canyon or walking a tight rope between Manhattan skyscrapers. Real courage isn't even playing in the Super Bowl! Although it might be hosting a Super Bowl party! Real courage is: "Yes, I will be of service to you and for you." "Together let's cut down on the drinking. I don't like to be without, but I have difficulty being with you when ...." "I'll sit here until we talk about ... is there something ...." "Mom, Dad, I need to tell you ...." "Hey, we have a lot, can we share with ...." "I believe there is an injustice over there, let's do ....."

Me, gifted? Me, able to do something? Me? Who are you talking to? You don't know me! I'm a nobody. I don't have much. I've never done much. I don't want to cause no trouble. We're better off singing: "Home on the Range." I began turning a blind eye to that a long time ago, why don't you do the same. It hasn't gone away, but I don't notice it any longer and my blood pressure has dropped significantly.

Who was Mother Teresa but a homely little nun – fierce as a freight train but as fragile as an egg shell. Who were Nelson Mandela, Dorothy Day, Abraham Lincoln, and Rosa Parks? Just nobodies--but nobodies who said, "I'm mad as can be and I'm not gonna take it anymore!" Listen to Helen Reddy sing: "I am woman, hear me roar in numbers too big to ignore!" Real courage is coward's courage: the courage that says, "I can't! But I'll try!" Every hero has lights that could not be extinguished. What they thought they couldn't do they went out and did.

When was the last time you gave honest consideration to your light? Has someone been deprived of the grace God gave you?

Think of the flicker of hope - one kindness, one courageous act, can kindle. Together all of us are the beacon of Christ's aliveness when we glorify our heavenly Father. We are the community of Jesus – that makes us a community of somebodies. Let's live the message of Scripture with vigor, vitality, serving and loving others as Christ has commanded us. Does that challenge us?

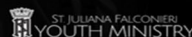

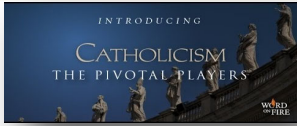

\* President Trump reinstated the Hyde Amendment prohibiting Federal funding for abortions in federal health plans (with the exception of rape and incest and when the life of the mother is endangered).

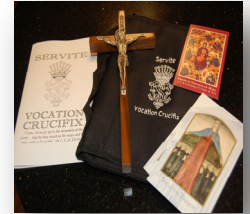

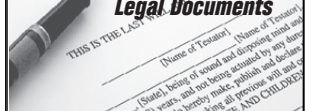
