Last Friday I suddenly began a trip down Lent's Nostalgia Lane.

I enjoyed growing up Catholic. Strangely, perhaps, I was allowed to ask questions. Real education begins with questions - even doubt, rarely does it start with certitude except for the obvious. The answers I got were thoughtful, mostly. My mother and my best friend's mother, the good sisters at St. Catherine's in Anaheim, and the faculty of Servite were not "cookie cutters" nor were they outrageous either to the right or left. I am grateful to them. Over the years I have sought spiritual directors who were of the same ilk. I believe if the pendulum swings too much to the rational side - reason without faith - the tendency is toward atheism. If the pendulum stays too much to the unquestioned side or faith without reason the tendency is toward fideism. Extremes are not healthy generally.

When Lent comes around often there is a sigh: "I better decide what to give up" or "I gotta do something different" and the resolution lasts a while. Face it, New Year's Day and Ash

Wednesday are most likely twins. Some Catholics "white knuckle" it all the way from Ash Wednesday to Holy Thursday evening. But why?

The intention of any act makes all the difference, whether in a court of law or in the practice of religious belief. The point of the fast is to be aware of your need for salvation, to orient yourself to God, basically it's a prayer. In giving up you are "raising your heart and your mind to God." Is your Lenten resolution a prayer?

Many of us, speaking for myself, do not suffer giving up meat on the Fridays of Lent or any day for that matter, so I have to find something else. As a child, Mom made some of my favorite Italian pasta dishes on the Fridays of Lent. Linguini with olive oil and garlic (*aglio olio*) and anchovies, the secret ingredient, or linguini with white clam sauce (*vongole*) which also includes the secret ingredient. As the saying goes: "Thrift makes the best sauce" and those sauces were about the best alternative to "red gravy" with long fusilli, another favorite noodle. The difficult meal of the season was finding enough tartar sauce to smother the fish stick lunch we were served at St. Catherine's or being able to serve ourselves and not have one of the sisters drop too much macaroni and cheese on my plate; Mom made neither. Giving up meat does not fulfill Lent for me. So, substitute other good actions for abstinence from meat as long as the substitute is a reminder of the need for conversion. Is it an act that frees you from "disordered affections" and directs you to the "things that eternally endure"?

For Lent and for your life-long and life-giving conversion to God: carry out some good action as suggested by Matthew 25:31-46, control your desire for more possessions and more entertainment - give some possession or money to those who do not have adequate "stuff", consider what you regularly confess as a sin and make a stronger effort to "amend your life", pray with Scripture and read a good spiritual book for the same reason, make prayer a better habit than it is or develop it as a habit if it is not one YET. Stop at the church in the morning, during the day when you want quiet time, or on your way home to pray, it is open from 6:15AM until 10:30PM, Monday to Friday. Spend time on the first Tuesday each month at Exposition.

Now, there is a real parish need! We are in real need of people to cover the twenty-four hours of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. St. Juliana, our patroness, had a strong devotion to the Blessed Sacrament. PLEASE, let's find strength, direction, and support in keeping the twenty-four hours of Exposition alive. Participation is especially needed from 11PM-6AM. Please make time for this time of conversion and discipleship. Start now to plan for each First Tuesday of the month and our twenty-four hours of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. Thanks a zillion.
