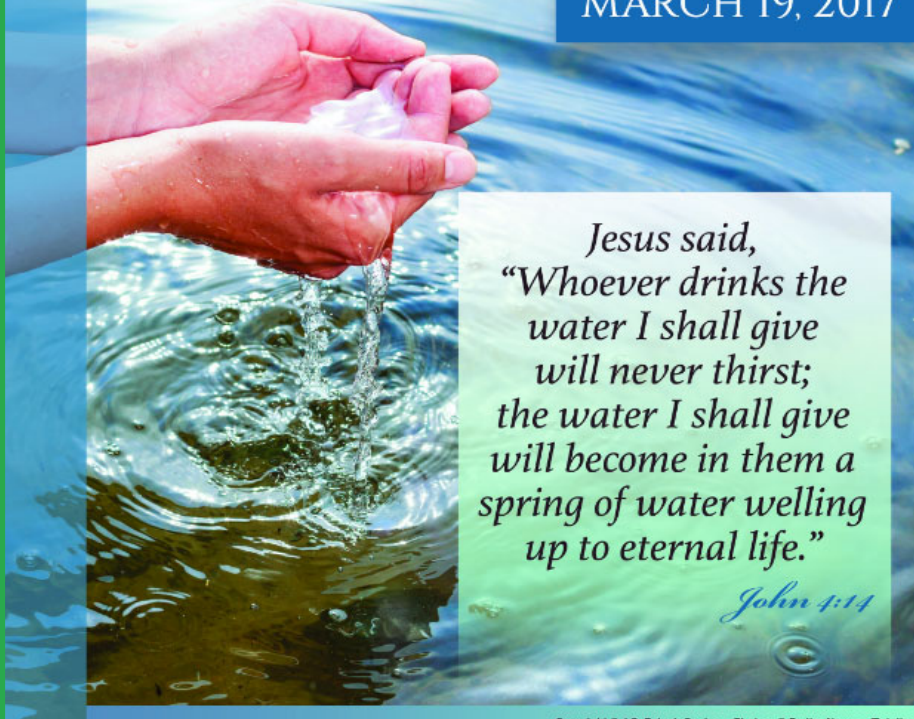

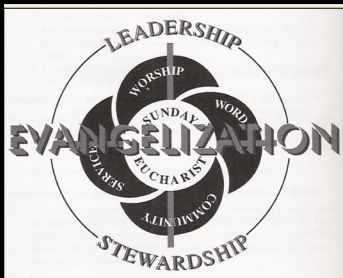

The Sunday lectionary readings for Lent this year are those of Cycle A. Frankly, these are the best! As the saying goes; “In my humble opinion” and being a pastor my opinion is always humble (!) of the three cycles of readings, these are the finest for our preparation for Easter Sunday.

The whole season of Lent might be taken as “Church, the People of God, on retreat.” During Lent, even if you don’t attend daily Mass or skip a Sunday, find the readings and pray with them. Say them aloud, go somewhere where people won’t think you have lost your wits, and listen to them. You can also find them read to you through your computer or smart device at, among other sites, www.usccb.org/bible/readings. Listen to the readings. USCCB is the official site of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) - it often has the answer to your questions!

To pray the passage and make us aware of the challenge of the Scripture, try these four steps. The first is to find the passage. The second is to listen to it actively – get the whole big picture of its presentation. The third is for you to decide to follow it; it is the Way to Salvation, the whole reason for reading and praying with Scripture. The fourth is to actually follow the Word of God to its final destination, God Himself. There is a difference between a saying “Yes, I’ll do an act” and actually doing it as directed.

The process is not much different from the way you and I most likely travel from point A to B these days. Although most of the time I believe I know the way or can figure it out easily enough, I rely on the “Maps” app on my, I am embarrassed to say “Smart Phone.” The phone used to be just a phone, perhaps it was a white phone or a “princess phone” it never claimed to have any brain, smart phone! So I input the destination. The Smart Phone knows where it and I am. Finding the Scripture daily passage is your starting point.

Once the data is received – the Word of God – I listen to it. What is it asking of me? What turns must I take, how many tolls are required, and how far must I travel for my conversion to holiness? This is step two.

Step three is a harder one - I must decide to follow the directions of the Smart Phone App. Darn! Sometimes I don’t believe the directions. I know better, I’ll do it my way! There’s a chance I went a different way before and it worked. I’ll do it my way. NOTE: Doing it my way didn’t always work for St. Francis Albert Sinatra! Let’s do it the way of Siri. Let’s actually practice the way of the Lord. That way always works. Following their ego and not the Lord’s direction has gotten folks from Adam and Eve to each of us in trouble, sometimes great trouble. Let’s do as our coins indicate and “Trust in the Lord.” Decide to follow the Lord.

Next step gets even more difficult, to actually follow the Lord’s way to salvation. The invitation to share His life of holiness is his, the choice is ours. His we are, we belong to Him. We are spiritual beings on our way back to our Spiritual Father. He is the Way and the Truth. Follow Him.

This Lent and for the rest of your lives – make the Lord your destination.

Before we get too far removed from our Parish Gala – Thank you to Lisa Riehl and Ceylon Lambert and all of your **Gatsby Gala** members for one wonderful evening! It took more than an evening and two dedicated chair persons to plan and present this awesome evening that came and went so quickly and elegantly – we are blessed and we are grateful! Each year the Parish Gala committee hits a Grand Slam Home Run. The St. Juliana community and I are most grateful to each of you. I hope you notice and understand the direction of the event: “the Parish Gala.” **Our community is best when we recognize we are one parish and Catholic grammar school community united.** Thanks again and again to infinity. Ceylon Lambert is next year’s chairman.

The best Fish Fry in the Diocese of Orange is at St. Juliana Parish Center each Friday of Lent. Thank you Mary Gomez and Hash Hanz and your army of helpers! **GO FALCONS!** The community comes together to celebrate a meal and the joyful presence of each other during Lent. We are all most grateful to your talented and experienced leadership and the dedicated service given to each of us. How much fun can Lent be? **Please know that the Stations of the Cross are prayed at 7:00PM. As the meal gathers us together so does our prayerful remembrance of the Way of the Cross.**

I don’t want anyone to be caught off guard; if all works out, Mr. Pete Gray a Fire Fighter for Fullerton and one of our parishioners will present some important information to all of us the weekend of 25/26 March. He will instruct us on what to do in case we are in the church and there is a natural disaster or an act of violence. Every school, public places including churches in the Diocese of Orange are making such presentations. These instructions are not foreign to any of us. I want you to be directed and cared for.

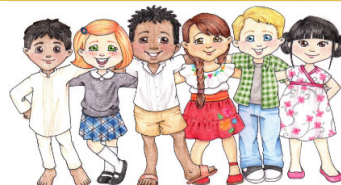

THIRSTING FOR LIFE-GIVING WATERS

Especially during the Lenten, Holy Week, and Easter seasons, the prayer texts of the Eastern Church revel in paradoxical images of Christ: the eternal life who is put to death, the host of the supper who is also its meal, the thirsty crucified one with living water streaming from his side. These images flow from the evangelists' portrayals of Jesus and from his very ministry, during which he often upset or reversed people's expectations about him or the ways of God. This "reversal" is at play in today's Gospel, as Jesus speaks to an enemy foreigner who is also a woman beneath his status. In addition he, the thirsting one, shows the woman to be the one truly thirsting. He—whose parched lips will say "I thirst" before he dies—is the source of life and life-giving water. Lent calls upon us to dwell on how each of us is thirsting for Christ, and it leads us, ultimately, back to the life-giving waters of our baptism into his Body.

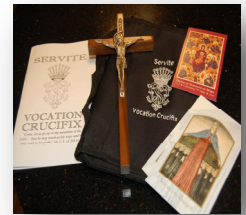

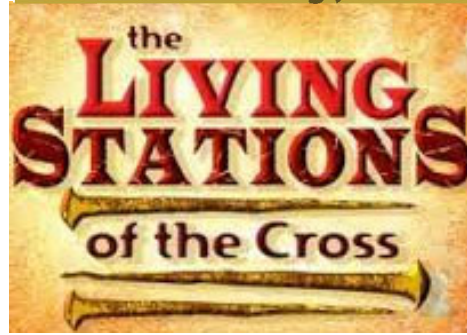
