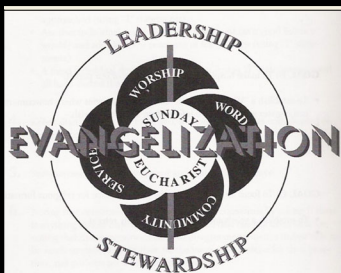

Several pastors I know dread addressing their parishes regarding the annual Pastoral Services Appeal (PSA). You make it easy! And I tell other pastors the good news of St. Juliana Parish. They respond: "Mike, you are a good pastor!" My comeback is always the same: "No, they are GREAT PARISHIONERS! I am lucky to have this parish!"

Might I tempt you once again to be great, even GREATER THAN LAST YEAR? We are great when we are the force of a community with a center. Here at St. Juliana parish the center does hold. In fact the debt on the Parish Center, another building which holds this parish together, is nearly paid in full. Our debt to the Diocese of Orange on the Parish Center building is \$98,800!

Our debt to the Diocese of Orange for the enhancements to the church is \$230,500. Today we owe the Diocese of Orange about \$330,000. The enhancement project is not complete, the church doors and the Melody Street entry are being designed. More debt will be added. Folks, you have been better than great! Let's hear it for the greatness of this faith community! Hip, Hip, HORRAY!



### Thank you so much, for doing so much, so well, for so long!

Here's the deal for this year. The Diocese of Orange has set our parish PSA assessment at \$113,000. Let us reach a parish goal of 550 individual pledges for a total campaign of \$225,000. Remember all donations over \$113,000 are returned to the parish for our use. I am confident that working together, young and old alike, we can reach and exceed the extraordinary goals. Why? Because you are an extraordinary parish.

For the past many years the rebates have been used to repay the parish debt to the Diocese of Orange. This year I propose a different use for the rebate. ***It is important that we begin to change our habits; the bills are nearly paid, let's set aside some new money for ministry – SERVICE TO YOU and SERVICE FOR YOU.*** This year, let's designate fifty percent of any rebate for debt service. The remaining fifty percent will be divided for ministry – thirty percent for ministry to youth and twenty percent for the liturgy. In this way we will continue to reduce our debt. We will also serve the needs of our youth, the next generation of Church. And we will enhance our liturgy. ***This change is a profound shift from fund raising to discipleship. It is a paradigmatic shift from debt service to the service of the community of faith; to conversion and celebration of the presence of the Lord of Life.***

With good reason, for many years, this community has enhanced older buildings and built new ones. Now is the time to renew ourselves as disciples of Jesus. We exist as a faith community to become holy and glorify God. That must lead us to encounter Jesus and form a life-long and life-giving relationship with him. Our task is to be made new in Christ. Parishioners, take advantage of faith formation classes at the grammar school, school of religious education, Confirmation preparation, adult faith formation series, small Christian communities, and etc. Be involved with others in programs of service and outreach ministry such as St. Vincent DePaul, Bereavement, the liturgical ministries of Reader, Eucharistic Minister, Hospitality, and music – we have three different choirs! Conversion calls us to live our faith in new ways. How do you do it? How do you live it?

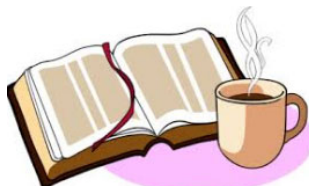
