## A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

This Sunday, we arrive at the week our Church calls “HOLY”. It’s the week that changed forever. How will you and your family keep it HOLY?

Many Roman Catholic high students complete a KAIROS retreat usually during their junior or senior years. Kairos is not an acronym; rather it’s a word of Greek origin which means “the right or opportune moment.” Kairos takes a person away from clock or chronological time and finds time not according to a clock but, in a religious sense according to God when something of significance can happen.

The New Testament Greek authors used kairos to mean: "the appointed time in the purpose of God", the time when God acts ). "Kairos" (used 86 times in the New Testament) refers

to an opportune time.

Use this week, especially Holy Thursday evening at 7:00PM, Good Friday afternoon beginning at 1:00PM, and the Great Easter Vigil beginning at 7:00PM as an opportune time to allow the great Feast of Easter to change your life.

The passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus is the path we follow to New Life. It is what gives meaning to every decision we make. Our faith is not only about the Cross of Christ but the way we live our life at the crossroads each day.

Make a decision to be with the community as we are with the Lord.

At each of the three ceremonies, which make the One Great Easter Feast, take yourself off of the clock and find that opportune moment, when the salvation is won for you and becomes significant.

The celebration of Holy Thursday includes the call to service, the Feast of the Table of the Lord celebrated in memory of One Great Night. It’s the night of the institution of The Supper that never ends. It concludes with the transfer of the Lord, Holy Eucharist, out of the church and into a place of rest.

The Solemn Ceremony of Good Friday recounts the death of Jesus. As you listen to the Passion Narrative what overpowers you? Are your sensitivities startled? What of the anguish of the Mother of Jesus? For whom do you have empathy, compassion, or contempt? Who and what will stand a chance of changing your life?

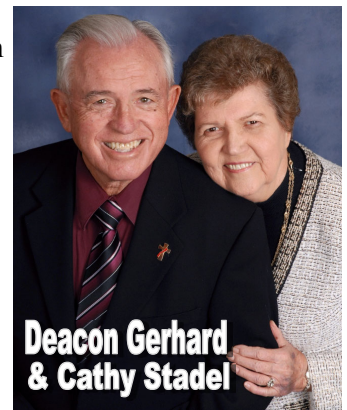
The Great Easter Vigil pulls out all of the stops. Symbols abound! Water. Fire. Light. The sounds of the choir and orchestra! BRING BELLS TO CHURCH, RING THEM DURING THE GLORIA!

During this week, step into the mystery of our salvation. May the ceremonies and the celebration be an opportunity for you to renew your faith. If you have a family, please worship as a family – together you are stronger!



St. Junipero Serra, the founding pastor of our Diocese used “*Siempre Adelante*” - meaning “Always Forward!” A cleric – deacon, priest, bishop – is normally transferred to a different ministry or ministry location after a period of time.
