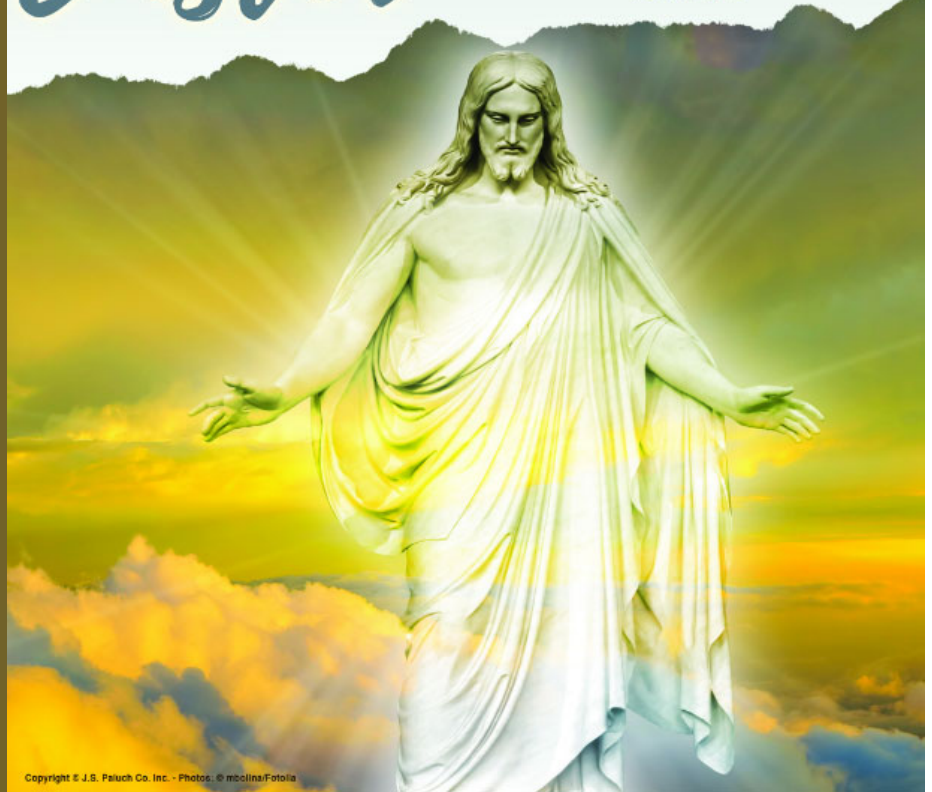

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Today we have a conflict. The Roman Church celebrates the Fifth Sunday of Easter – however, today is Mother’s Day! Mother’s Day is not a Church Sunday. It’s a Sunday from Hallmark Cards, FTD Florist, and every restaurant and chocolate factory. **Happy Mother’s Day – Happy Day to all Moms.**

The Scripture lessons today do not celebrate Mom – or do they? “The number of disciples continued to grow” – “The word of God continued to spread” – “Lord, let your mercy be on us, as we place our trust in you” - “You are a chosen race” – Do not let your hearts be troubled” – and finally: “No one comes to the Father except through me.”

My Mom, and I hope yours, taught all of that. It was through the maternal side of the family that I learned to have faith in God and how to practice it. Mom made me strong when I felt weak and up when I was down. Don’t be afraid or troubled, we’ll get through it all. I have difficulty getting through the play “Gypsy” – and not thinking of Mom. The song “Everything’s Coming Up Roses” and the narrative that leads up to it was my Mom and I hope yours.

“No one comes to the Father except through me” is so reminiscent of a favorite narrative from the comedian Shelley Berman. Shelley admits that his best is called “Father and Son.” (youtube it.) It begins with, “I called home asking my mother for advice. She gave me that same strong maternal advice she always gave me: ‘Talk to your father!’”

A favorite memory of my Mom will always be “Sunday pasta.” The smell of “Sunday gravy” woke me up by 7:30AM every single Sunday I was ever home. When I explained that at her funeral, our next door neighbor headed directly for me and remarked in a somewhat huffy tone: “Fr. Mike, on Sunday mornings YOU got to sleep until 7:30AM, we are awake before then. Our bedrooms faced her kitchen! When she got the new stove and blower – that smell; garlic, tomato, and oregano, came to us long before it got to the other side and up the stairs of your home.” I remarked: “It’s not a smell, that was aroma! (A ROMA!) You were still the lucky ones, you got Sunday pasta quite often at our table.” They were wonderful neighbors. No one was sad when Mom was around. How I miss her now!

After experiencing Jesus, people in the crowd ponder: “We know where he came from. We know who his parents are. Where did he get all of that?” A direct answer can be given: “His MOM.” I believe it was through Mary that Jesus learned what children learn from their Mothers – dressing yourself, mercy, kindness, compassion, patient suffering, feeding others, and the rest. Picking up your clothing is another matter.

Love your Mom. Not only today, but always.

Thank you for all of the greetings and gifts I received on the occasion of my thirty-fifth anniversary of ordination. I appreciate the way you accept me and my nonsense.

If you were away last week and did not read the bulletin. The final payment has been made on the mortgage loan of \$4,000,000 for the Parish Center. You all accomplished the feat ahead of schedule and without further interest payments. ALLELUIA, ALLELUIA, ALLELUIA. A parish celebration will be scheduled – look for Saturday, June 24th. Plans are not final at this time.

The front Melody Lane entry to our church is being designed. We have collected \$100,000 for it. That was the gift of parishioner (\$50K) and a generous non-parishioner (\$50K). Let’s use the \$50K as a challenge – can we, as the parish community, match \$50K? If you would like to be part of the challenge – use an envelope or write “entry” on your check. Thank you so much.

If you would like to contribute to any of the recent church enhancements, please do so. Our debt is \$135K. Kindly mark your donation “enhancements.” Your name, if you wish, will be placed on a donor board. If you wish to be anonymous, we will keep your name and donation confidential.

Lastly, we have reached our PSA goal for the Diocese. All PSA donations received now will be returned to the parish. The use of those funds will be for Youth Ministry, Sunday Liturgy, and debt reduction.

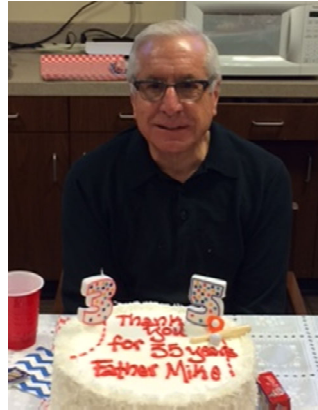

MAY CROWNING

We were very blessed last week to have our school children crown Mary with a wreath of flowers. A May crowning is a ceremony in May, a month traditionally dedicated to Mary, in



which parishioners (often children) crown a statue of Mary with a wreath of flowers. Catholics began honoring Mary this way in the Middle Ages. By the 19th century, when it became common to assign different Catholic devotions to different months — the Rosary in October, for instance, or the Sacred Heart of Jesus in June — it was only natural to dedicate all of May to Mary. Try putting together a simple May altar in your home this year, with a statue of

Mary and a simple vase of fresh flowers — even dandelions or lilacs from your yard, picked by family members.

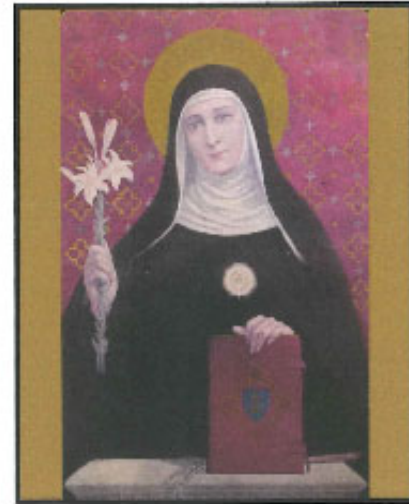

CATHOLIC CD AVAILABLE - MOST HOLY ROSARY RECORDING LED BY VIN SCULLY!

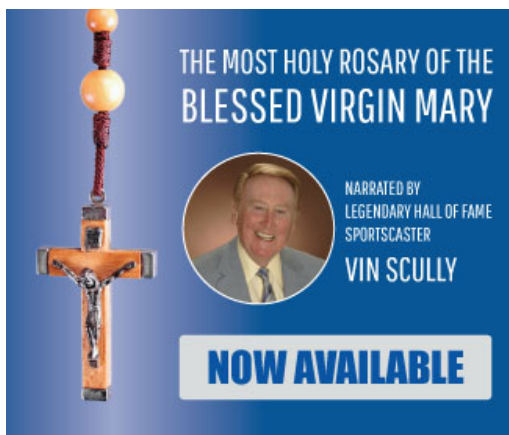
