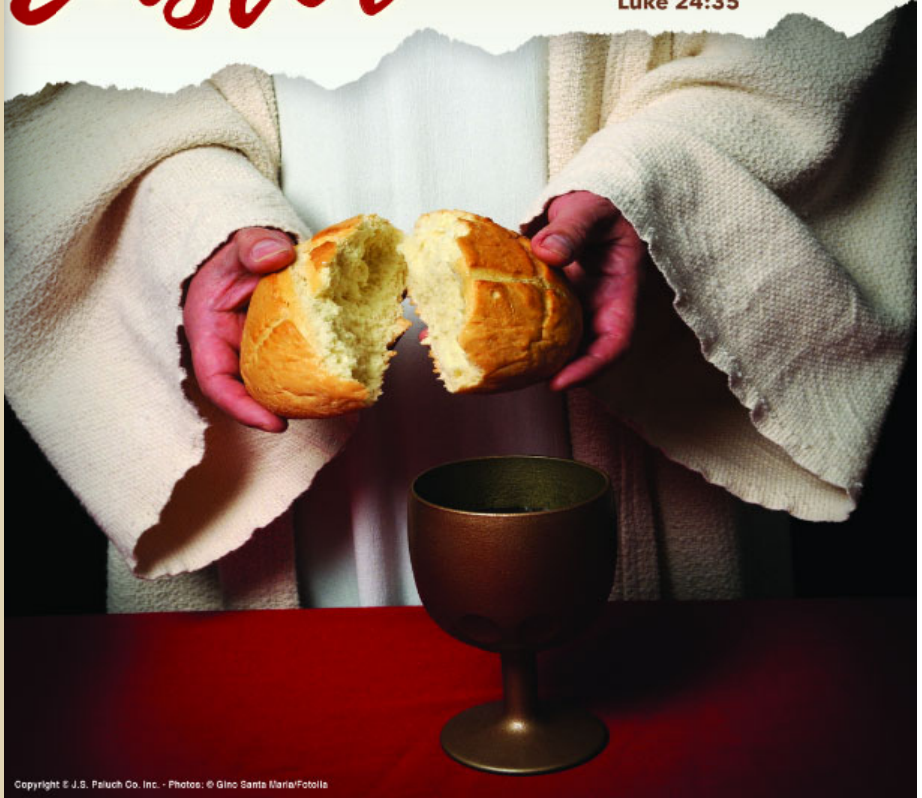

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Perhaps you are doing it! Perhaps you haven't noticed it! Perhaps you should be part of it!

So, what's the "it"? Stopping your day, making time for prayer, and coming to the church to pray.

Since Ash Wednesday I have noticed an increased number of adults and school children simply stopping in the church to as we say: "Pay a visit". It's a most encouraging sight! I've noticed college students and I've emailed and spoken to Fr. Mark the Cal State University Fullerton chaplain to tell him; "There are X number of college students in St. Juliana Church RIGHT NOW! You are doing something really great." I thank them for coming, they thank me for providing such a fine church and keeping it open. I've noticed and talked with parents who tell me that their grammar school students asked if a stop could be made to pray in the church before they head for home or after school sports. A few Saturdays ago some First Communion children and their parents were taking pictures in Acacia Park. Together they came to the church for a time of prayer. Parents and Grand-parents stop in the church during drop off or pick up student time. Let me repeat; "it's most encouraging."

A moment in the church is a moment spent well.

Time is set aside, scheduled, for so many good and necessary things; exercise, playing bridge, bowling, walking the dog, washing the car, and etc. Regularly, time is spent for important moments of life; sharing the family meal, Sunday Pasta, conversing with children and spouses, visiting loved ones in hospitals, vacation, reading novels, non-fiction, and reading Scripture. To make attending Mass on the weekend important, schedule it. Participate in the community's worship.

The habit of prayer - prayer in the church is a time of grace. It's time you intentionally set aside to encounter the Lord in His house, on His turf. Hopefully, it's a time of peace and awesome wonder. It's a time to rejoice in the good so it is a time to give God thanks. It's a time to realize some hurt, therefore it is a time to plan reconciliation with another person and to ask God for pardon. It's a time to plan the future and ask God for direction and strength. It could be that if church prayer time were taken seriously there would be few problems and less stress.

Of course you can "pray anywhere". When was the last time you did that? We can also eat fast foods, but after a while some slow food is a treat you give yourself. You can sleep in a lot of places, classrooms and libraries; you'll find your own bed most comfortable. Ecclesiastes and The Byrds tell us there is a time for everything - where and when is your prayer time?

Beginning today or continuing into the future, give yourself a chance to encounter God - meet God where he dwells - give thanks, be reconciled, and plot a better tomorrow with your Great Friend."

We've spent money "enhancing" our parish church. Spend time in the church with its Sacred Inhabitant.

On the First Tuesday of the month, spend at least one hour of the twenty-four hours to adore our Lord as He is exposed on the altar. If possible, try one of the quiet hours of the late evening and early morning.

Make a habit of "paying a visit" in the church. The doors are open and the lights are on!

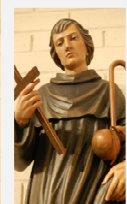

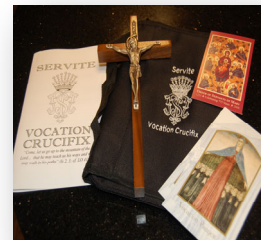

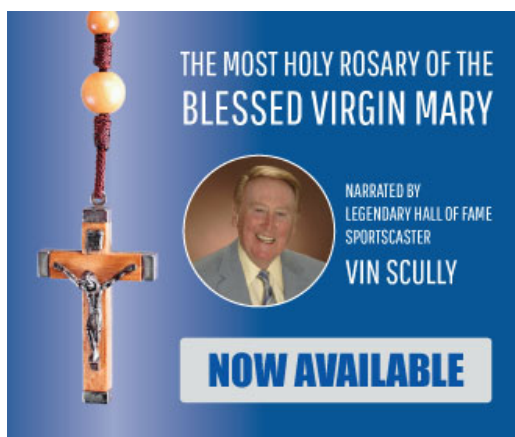
