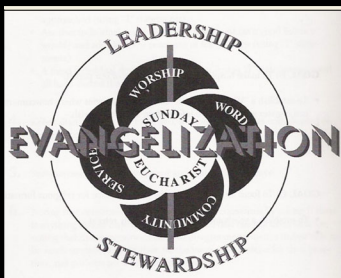

### A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

One of the gifts of the Holy Spirit is now called “Wonder and Awe” – some of us learned it as “Fear of the Lord”. Again and again I am convinced that a lot of us have lost “Wonder and Awe” – especially where God Himself is concerned. Has God become common place and ordinary? Has the world moved on without God? Is God so misrepresented in descriptions as to become boring? These are real questions and very valid concerns. Especially at a time when God seems to be dead.

Personally, I really struggle with Trinity Sunday. The feast presents itself as an opportunity for me to make too many heresies while preaching! It also becomes reduced itself to the very simple, if not simplistic. Is God simple? Has God become too complicated?

Perhaps the problem is that we try too hard. The other problem might be that we don’t try hard enough. What to do with a God whose self-expression is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit?

I’ve been spiritually energized by the spirit of Michelangelo on the Sistine Ceiling. WOW! The finger of God and the finger of Adam! The space in-between, it isn’t huge. Imagine that bit of power going from God’s finger to Adam’s finger. What would be in that charging exchange? I imagine. Life. Intelligence. Eternity. Forgiveness. Peace. Courage. Love.

God is telling us that we are made for Him. We learned that long ago: “Our purpose is to know, love, and serve God in this world so that we will be happy with Him in the next.” And He is right in front of us. In one being and three persons.

I can’t tell you how many ways the beautiful chapel of St. Catherine’s Academy in Anaheim has shaped my religious life. On the south wall is the “Window of Creation” – Almighty God surrounded by His Creation caught in the very act of Creation. Directly opposite Him, on the north wall, is Jesus His Son – huge in size, in many ways the mirror image of His Father. And on the western wall, is the Holy Spirit and the Act of Pentecost. The Creator, The Redeemer, The Lord and Giver of Life.

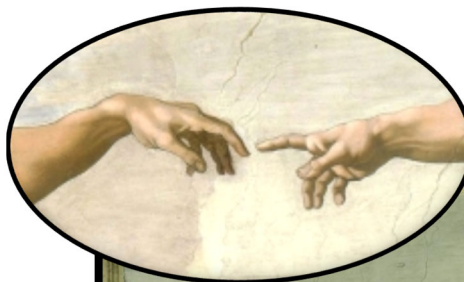
For too long, God has been taught as a noun. A three-leafed clover. Water – liquid, frozen ice, and vapor steam.

Imagine God as a verb! Picture the Trinity as **life** and **life-giving** as being and the source of existence. Like the inside of an atom. God moving faster than light, moving everywhere at once, generating existence that never ceases and never needs to be nourished or fed. God is present, directing, guiding, everyone, everywhere, all at once. He cannot not be!

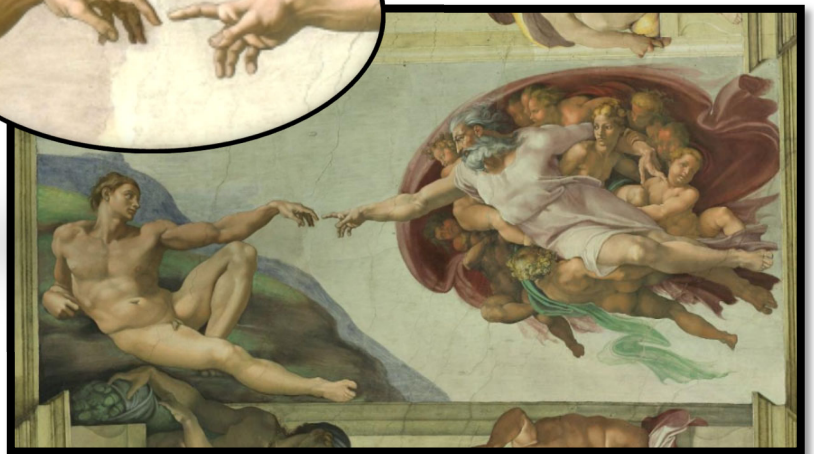
Yet I struggle like Helen Keller, groping through the sunshine, afraid that the next step will be the last step.

Frankly, I enjoy the muse. A spirituality of wonder gives life. It might be wrong, yet it provides a rather active inner life directed to God. For me it is guided by the Creed and in so many ways beats any catechism.

And a bit more. It is breathtaking. WOW!

## THE MOST HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY

It is often heard that today's observance is an "idea feast," and that it is somewhat difficult to grasp its meaning. Other great solemnities, such as Christmas and Easter, have an easily grasped core. Yet, even though the Trinity is at the heart of our faith, firmly declared in the Creed since the Council of Nicea in 325, we are used to having people shrug and say, "Well, it's a mystery."

Perhaps it is more helpful to think of this as a "relationship feast," since it unveils our deepest identity. Dorothy Day was a great social reformer, pacifist, and ardent lover of the Trinity. When people told her that she would certainly be canonized one day (the process is indeed underway), she protested dismissively by remarking that people were raising a fuss just because she was not afraid to talk about God. She loved the Trinity, and treasured the traditional icon for the feast, also known as "The Hospitality of Abraham," depicting the three angelic beings seated at a table tilted toward the viewer and laden with bread and wine. For her, the Trinity revealed the heart of the Catholic life, three C's if you will: **community, communication, and communion.** That was not an "idea" for her, but what it means to be created in the image of the Triune God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. —Rev.
