A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Musing about God I sat in prayer constructing an adequate image of God for myself. I did that for the first time many years ago. I still do it. I hope we all do. “What is God’s life like?” – “How does God experience our experiences?” Not only the good times and bad times, but time itself. How does God experience time?

There is a movement afoot in California to not change the clocks twice a year. Let’s keep the same time all year. Wrist watches have changed from ones that had to be wound every day, to ones that were automatically wound each time the wearer moved it, to a battery, and now to being charged and more like the cartoon watch of Dick Tracy than the very day Mickey Mouse watch or works of intricate mechanical complexity and genius.

Other markings of time include the seasons and the change seasons cause. Wearing warm clothing to wearing clothing that “wicks away body moisture.” Seasons change from football, basketball, hockey and fighting, to the polite national pastime of baseball. Once in a long while the Cubs win. We know from celebrating a birthdays and anniversaries each year that this is true: “time keeps slipping into the future”.

The Church marks liturgical time; we’ve moved from Advent to Ordinary Time to Lent to Easter to Pentecost and back to Ordinary time.

But how might God experience time? Our answer will be a guess prompted by prayerful reflection on God’s own attributes.

We believe that God is “outside of time.” That’s a good portion of what we mean when we say that God cannot age or change. Age and change is a measured result of time.

I suppose if you were to ask God “what time is it?” He would always say: “Now.” For God time must always be in the present. God is eternally in the present. He cannot change as a result of time. He does not age.

But we do.

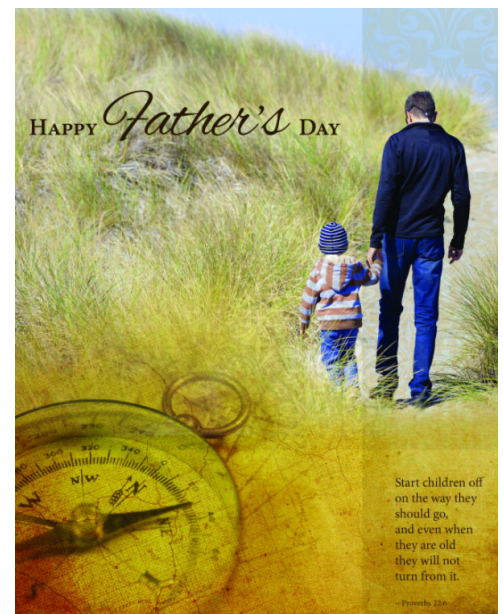
How are you changing your perception of God? What WAS God like for you and who is God like for you NOW, in the present? When was the last time you discussed God’s image and likeness, being and existence with anyone? Anyone close to you?

We call God “Father.” He creates, he launches, he provides, he guides, and does all the wonderful life-giving acts a Good Father does for his loved ones.

Happy Father’s Day! This is your day! Dad, you create, launch, provide, guide, and do all those wonderful life-giving acts a Good Father does for your family and community called “church.” If we haven’t said it often enough - so many times when you loved us – thank you, we love you.

Dad, it’s not like Mother’s Day. You might be asked to fire up the grill and cook for us, we are grateful when we are gathered around the table with you. You might be asked to take us for a Sunday outing, we are happy to pile in the car and go with you; we won’t ask you to ask for directions once we are lost – and you will get us lost - it’s a Dad’s thing. We’ll be lost with you. Enjoy the tie, funny underclothes, and a new map app.

Most of all Dad, Father, we love you. Please don’t age. We love you as you are presently, right now.

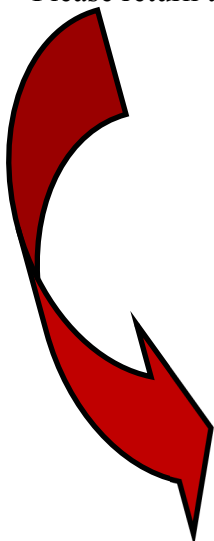

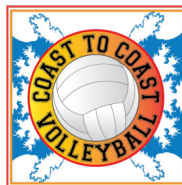

Our hope and prayer is to be able to have our monthly 24 hour Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on this national holiday — but if we do not have enough sign-ups, we may need to scale back the hours.

Did you know:

Exposition and benediction of the Blessed Sacrament is not only a very old devotion in our Church, but one that highlights the fundamental mystery of the Holy Eucharist—that **our Lord is truly present, body and blood, soul and divinity in the Blessed Sacrament.**

In his 1980 Holy Thursday letter to priests, *Dominicae cenae*, Pope John Paul II wrote,

"Since the Eucharistic mystery was instituted out of love, and makes Christ sacramentally present, it is worthy of thanksgiving and worship. And this worship must be prominent in all our encounters with the Blessed Sacrament..." (#3).

While emphasizing the importance of the Mass, the Holy Father then recommends various forms of Eucharistic devotion: personal prayer and periods of adoration before the Blessed Sacrament, etc. All of these devotions which focus on the Blessed Sacrament aid in our spiritual union with our Lord. As Jesus said,

"I myself am the Bread of Life. No one who comes to me shall ever be hungry, no one who believes in me shall ever thirst" (John 6:35). ~ 2017 Catholic Straight Answers

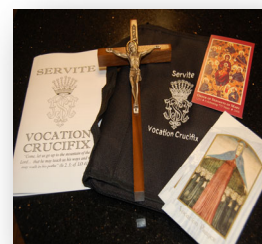

Ashley McPartlin, Legislative Coordinator, outlines some of the very bad legislation now making its way through the Capitol.
 AB 569—OPPOSE—by Gonzalez-Fletcher. Bill would prohibit churches or other organizations and employers from disagreeing with an employee’s ‘reproductive health care decisions’ including abortions.
 SB309—OPPOSE—Establishes a specialty license plate, celebrating abortion in California.
 SB320 —OPPOSE—Would require State Universities and Community Colleges to provide chemical abortifacients (such as RU486) to students.
 SB481—OPPOSE—A court case (The Chapman decision) found widespread nursing home abuse via declaring unwanted patients to be ‘incompetent’ and then intentionally denying them essential care. This bill by Pan, allows nursing homes to continue the practice, but to protect the institution from legal implications, they would give the newly declared ‘incompetent person’ a note stating they were incompetent. They then would be free to continue to remove medical care.
 SB 562— OPPOSE— Universal, single-payer health coverage, the State of California would ‘take care’ of all Californians. Abortion would receive unlimited funding.
 SB 743—OPPOSE— Ensure government funding of abortions under all medi-cal providers and Planned parenthood.
 SCA 7—SUPPORT— Repeals the failed multi-billion dollar Embryonic ‘Stem Cell and Cures’ Act.
