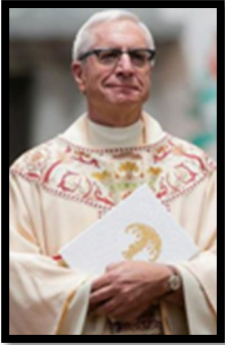

I've enjoyed the brief course in morality. We've come to a fork in the road. Yogi Berra, the great Yankee catcher, famous for "Yogi-isms" said: "When you come to a fork in the road, take it." Well, Yogi, I will. As we continue let's take a slight right turn. Being that we are in Orange County, CA, we know to turn only to the right! "If you don't know where you are going, you'll end up someplace else." Thanks again, Yogi! Morality is ALWAYS a turn to the right.

I mentioned that "laws are for people who don't think." They are also for people who lack "fellow-feeling." Empathic people need fewer laws than narcissists.

Empathy: a noun. **Empathy** is the capacity to understand or feel what another person is experiencing from within their frame of reference, that is, the capacity to place oneself in another's position. (Thanks Wikipedia and Google; you've given us a start.)

Movies or books that teach empathy include: *To Kill A Mockingbird*, *Huckleberry Finn*, *Ordinary People*, *On Golden Pond*, *Bambi*, *A Christmas Carol*, *Peanuts* cartoons, and a current book, *The Hillbilly Elegy*. Reflect on Jesus' attention to those in need especially the parables of the Prodigal Son, the Good Samaritan and the Great Judgment in Matthew 25. Whenever you read: "And his heart was moved with pity" think empathy and compassion.

Empathy and compassion are twins! They involve fellow-feeling, the right moral choice. Morality directs us to be fully human; to direct our tendencies in the right direction. Risk identifying with the other, then experience the other's life, raising that one or group to a better way of living.

Feelings of the heart really can't be faked. Charity and courtesy can be faked; watch *Leave It To Beaver* and concentrate on the character of Eddie Haskell. If your goal is only completing service hours, not helping the other sincerely – you are a fake! When someone is "there for you" it means they can feel your pain. They are the real deal.

Are you helping another by your action or word? Empathy directs us into the life of other humans by identifying with their human experience. I'm a fellow human being, I'm here to help you. Who after kicking a dog and hearing it "YIP" would try it a second time? After kicking the dog, why would you kick a human being?

If you truly love, identify, understand, and serve the needs of others in the same way as you love yourself – how much more human would your communities be? Wouldn't your home, school, workplace, or church, wouldn't our country be different if empathy were exercised?

Empathic communities have consequences too: over-crowding. Once more along with Yogi Berra we could say: "No one goes there nowadays; it's too crowded."

From our treasury of prayers:

Eucharistic Prayer III for various needs:

Grant that all the faithful of the Church, looking into the signs of the times by the light of faith may constantly devote themselves to the service of the Gospel.

Keep us attentive to the needs of all that, sharing their grief and pain, their joy and hope, we may faithfully bring them the good news of salvation...

Eucharistic Prayer IV for various needs:

(red additions are mine):

Open our eyes to the needs of our brothers and sisters;

inspire in us (**compassionate**) words and (**merciful**) actions

to comfort those who labor and are burdened.

Make us serve them truly; after the example of Christ and at his command (**to love one another**).

And may your church stand as a living witness to truth and freedom, to peace and justice, that all people may be raised up to a new hope.

And then there were none!

By simple definition, the liturgy (MASS) is the work of the people. Many ministries, all important to the Mass, come together to unify the experience of celebrating God's presence among us.

The ministry of hospitality – usher – is one such necessary ministry especially for large celebrations of the community.

Arriving about ten to fifteen minutes before Mass begins, hospitality ministers welcome everyone—they welcome those familiar to the community and visitors into the church, as they enter the doors. They direct folks not seated to a seat, take up the collection and recruit members of the community to bring the offerings to the altar. Communion lines are directed by hospitality ministers. If there is a second collection, they gather that collection. Following Mass they distribute bulletins and make sure the church is in reasonably tidy order before they leave. If there is an emergency during the Mass they notify 911 responders and file incident forms.

In short their ministry is important, not casual. It's the work of the liturgy—so the liturgy will work!

 Delivery is on Saturday, December 8th.



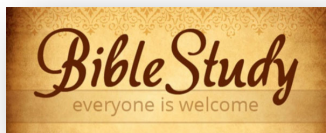

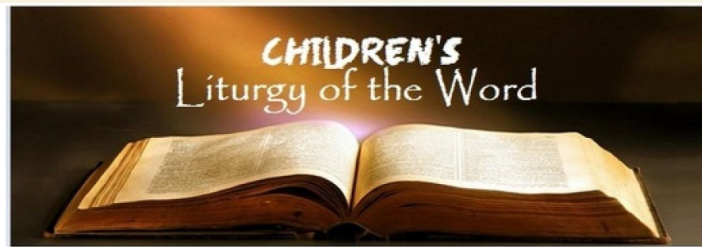

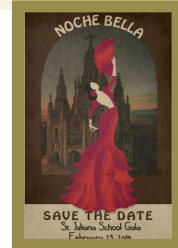
