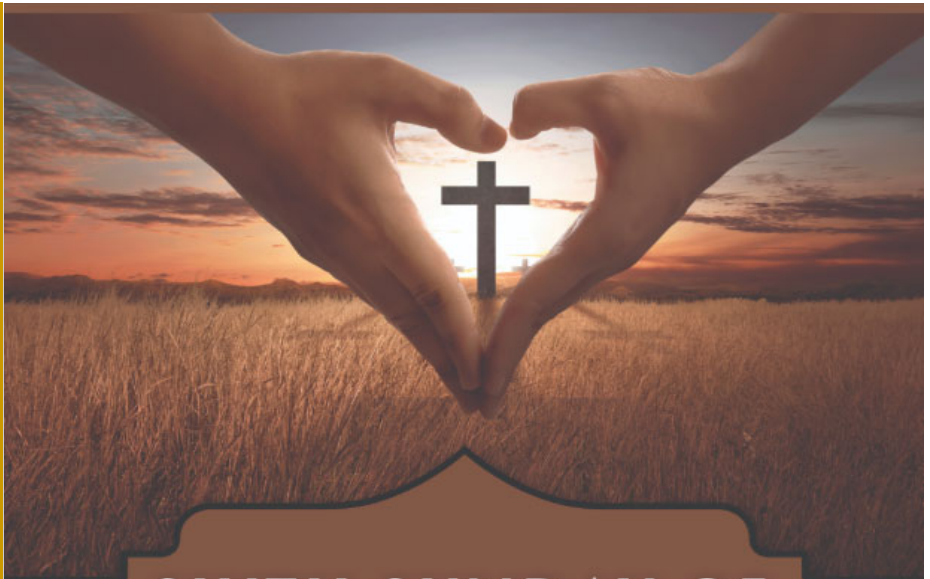

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

A wonderful priest taught me in the college seminary, he could keep our attention with his homilies. When he was well prepared he could create parables, folktales, and the like that brought the Scripture lesson to life. When he wasn't prepared he preached thusly: "Gentlemen - **GOD** is love, God **IS** love, God is **LOVE**. **GOD IS LOVE**. Remember the primary lesson." That would be the unprepared but not uninspiring homily. Mass continued and lunch followed. The lesson has not been forgotten.



Another lesson I learned long ago in high school was: "The greatest gift that God has given us is that He has let us in on the secret of who He is and what He is all about." The lesson has not been forgotten.

Both of those lessons are in today's readings. Don't forget them. Practice them; they bring life to faith and faith to life.

If you want joy, love as Jesus commands. Love the way God loves. He simply cannot leave us, the crown of His creation, alone. Covenants were made until the "New and Everlasting Covenant" was established. Don't leave anyone alone – reveal God's love to the people with whom you encounter; neighbors, workers, schoolmates, and etc. As best you can give God's love, extend His life, to everyone. Love one another is Jesus' commands. Keep his commandment. Do your neighbors know that you belong to the Body of Christ at St. Juliana Falconieri Parish by the way you live Jesus' command? God is love, share His love.

Jesus left us many examples of how to extend his love to others. Although the Final Judgement scene of Matthew 25: 31-46 is quite direct, another way to love is to become the Good Samaritan, the heretical outsider who cares for others in such a way as to provide compassion and companionship. Still another way to extend love is to welcome someone to your home, as Martha and Mary did, or to have a party as the Prodigal Father does to welcome his wayward son back home. In any case, it's the doting over the other that matters. Have you been doted over lately? Have you doted over someone else lately?

God has been revealed to you – don't keep Him a secret from others. These are lessons, Gospel lessons, not to be forgotten.

Here's the nugget: The Easter weekday readings are chosen from the Acts of the Apostles. Day after day we read and study the way the early Church grew. It grew because the Apostles were excited, lively, and joy filled. They could not be repressed. Today and now you can share your faith life with others

Congratulations to the eighty-three young members of our community who were sealed with the Holy Spirit – they received the Sacrament of Confirmation on Friday, May 4th. The second graders of our Catholic grammar school and School of Religious Education Faith Formation program received Holy Eucharist for the first time on April 28. Congratulations to the youth and thank you for your courage to continue your faith journey with us. Thank you to our parish and school staff and volunteers who prepared them for this moment. Especially thank you to parents and family where faith is nurtured. As a community let's assist our younger members in bringing to completion the good work begun with them.
