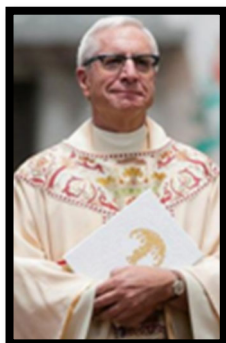

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Let’s reflect for a moment on how do we grow in our faith. More specifically, how did and do YOU grow in the faith that you celebrate? If you were baptized as an infant, a blessing prayer was said over your father: “Together with your wife you will be the first teachers to your children of the ways of the faith. May you also be the best of teachers.” Perhaps you went on to – or were sent to endure – a few or many more years of Catholic School. Hopefully it was more than Catholic brain washing. And if it was brain washing, where are all the products of Catholic schools on Sundays or weekday Mass? After school or religious education, what happened? Did you grow, age and mature, but your faith didn’t? How to enliven that salt?

I hear that a lot, that faith is not relevant to life; the Church ought to get with the times. That faiths’ rituals are boring – they ought to be more of a celebration. For some part, those criticisms are correct, while some criticism is simply misguided. Parish faith formation courses and evenings allow the parish to grow in our understanding of faith. Such faith formation evenings are planned in August – August 5, 12, and 19 – please join us for and following the 5:00PM Mass on those days. You need not come to the 5:00PM Mass; following the Mass there will be supper and a talk. The children will have supervised play outside. A good way to grow in faith during the summer.

Today is Father’s Day! Happy Day, Dads! What do we learn from any father: clarity. On Father’s Day it is good to reflect on that in connection to the Gospel. Jesus spoke in a such a way that the disciples could understand. Clarity, what we expect of Fathers – the paternal figure in the family and in the parish! By that I mean an honest perception of the evidence, no matter what the problem. A conclusive decision about what ought to be done. Not a bad role for a Father.

Mom’s role might be, rightly or wrongly, understanding, empathy, seeing a problem from a child’s point of view. Simply because from the earliest days of the child’s life, before the child was capable of words, Mom had to intuit what the child needed.

What might you do this summer – grow your faith in God and in your Family. Begin today with a Gospel reading of Growth – end with a vacation to see God’s beauty and close comfort of a family. Sort of reminds me of that old slogan: “Tour the USA in a Chevrolet.” Let Dad do the driving, Mom do the praying, kids you can play “Words With Friends”. Try not to cheat.

Fill your plate with faith!

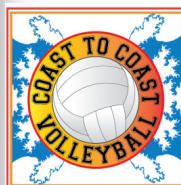

In his 1980 Holy Thursday letter to priests, *Dominicae cenae*, Pope John Paul II wrote,
"Since the Eucharistic mystery was instituted out of love, and makes Christ sacramentally present, it is worthy of thanksgiving and worship. And this worship must be prominent in all our encounters with the Blessed Sacrament..." (#3).

While emphasizing the importance of the Mass, the Holy Father then recommends various forms of Eucharistic devotion: personal prayer and periods of adoration before the Blessed Sacrament, etc. All of these devotions which focus on the Blessed Sacrament aid in our spiritual union with our Lord. As Jesus said,
"I myself am the Bread of Life. No one who comes to me shall ever be hungry, no one who believes in me shall ever thirst" (John 6:35). ~ 2017 Catholic Straight Answers

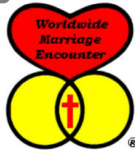
