A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

We believe the Eucharist to be nothing-less-than “bread and wine transformed” into the Body and Blood of Jesus, The Savior. In an inspiring piece of American poetry, the *Battle Hymn of the Republic*, we sing of “In the beauty of the lilies Christ was born across the sea, with a glory in his bosom that transfigures you and me...” Our religious journey toward God calls us to conversion; changing from the imperfect to the perfect, from the secular to the holy, from selfishness and sin to service of the other in love and toward a lasting relationship, of grace. We are awakened to our true selves when we encounter beauty.

Beauty, found in the words of literature and expression of visual art, always coming from reflective depths of the human experience, has a unique way of transforming, transfiguring, and converting each of us. As we encounter beauty, its excellence is powerful and attractive. Beauty is taken into us, to our deepest selves.

We are all headed toward one sight, one vision – the sight of God, the beatific vision. Christians see differently. We Christians have given, especially Western Civilization, a distinctive spice in art, whether that art be in the letters of literature including music or visual art works.

The real beauty, of literature and visual art, awakens every sensitive soul. Real beauty – which is not subjective - is a breath of fresh air which lifts us up and connects all the dots once more. Leading us to the beatific vision, it literally points us to God, to heaven our final home.

Good literature and fine art explains kindness and redemption even in moments, perhaps years, when the soul is filled with sadness and darkness. Once beauty is seen and experienced, the human life is changed.

You cannot be indifferent to beauty or unaffected by it. Beauty simply makes one exclaim “WOW!”. It is beauty that we identify with, and it is beauty that gives life a meaning and purpose. Literature and visual art are simply ways to heaven. Come, see, and be converted.

It is with this hope of transformation, transfiguration, and conversion for each of us that I have invited Msgr. Michael Heher, pastor of St. Anne’s Parish in Seal Beach to speak with us on Flannery O’Connor and Fr. Paul Addison, OSM from London to speak on Mary in Art among other topics in the month of August. These evenings are being funded via the PSA rebate and general faith formation fund of the parish.

REFLECTIONS ON READINGS

WHAT THORN . . . ?

The Holy Spirit from time to time draws the veil of silence across a particular passage of scripture. Paul's "thorn in the flesh" in today's second reading is one of those silent places, for Paul—much to the frustration of centuries of Christians—never tells us precisely what his thorn in the flesh is. His friends in Corinth most likely knew what he was referring to, which was enough for him. People have speculated that the thorn was anything from bad eyesight to rampant lust. But all this speculation misses the point, for in his weakness, Paul comes to know and live the paradox of the cross of Christ: *it is in our weakness that God's greatest strength can be made manifest.* When we are strong, we imagine the strength is ours; when we are weakest, we know that any strength or power we might have comes from God alone.

THE THORN OF SELF-DOUBT

The neighbors and family of Jesus in Mark's Gospel passage today think that Jesus has a thorn: his dubious credentials to be a teacher in the synagogue or a worker of mighty deeds. Some of us might think that we have this "thorn" of insufficient qualifications to be witnesses for God's plan of salvation in Christ. Sometimes we use this imaginary "thorn" of ours to excuse ourselves from the challenging work of living "thy kingdom come" or to lead ourselves into a false humility about our inadequacy as disciples. We can learn a lesson from Jesus and Paul today. Each of us, in spite of physical or personal shortcomings or limitations (real or imagined), is called and chosen to be a messenger of the saving grace of God, each in our own way. Whether we are spouse, parent, child, student, worker, employer— whatever role we have in life, God can work in us and through us to be signs of grace for others. When we find ourselves afflicted with the thorn of self-doubt, let us use that weakness to find our strength in God, and through our faith in Christ, continue to proclaim the Good News of salvation.
