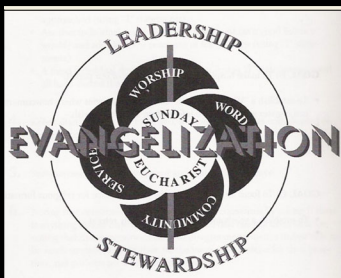

NEW LITURGICAL DIRECTIVE FROM BISHOP VANN FOR THE CONGREGATION AND EXTRA ORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION EFFECTIVE BEGINNING AUGUST 11/12, 2018.

All communion chalices will be prepared with wine during the preparation of the gifts, no Communion ministers will be needed to fill the chalices at the fraction rite any longer.

Congregation: After the Lamb of God and until your pew goes to receive Holy Communion, please kneel.

Ministers of the Holy Eucharist: While the priest and deacon receive Holy Communion come at once from your pews and receive Holy Communion. Please stand in front of the altar server chairs on the sacristy/ambo side of the altar. The first three should be the ones who would have been previously on the children's chapel side, the other four should be those who were on the ambo side. Distribution of Holy Communion will continue in the same way as it has been.



Please reverence the altar and tabernacle with a genuflection (if unless you are unable) when entering and exiting the church. The Blessed Sacrament is present in the center of our sanctuary. Once you have entered you need not genuflect again when you cross the church. Be welcoming and hospitable to everyone. Remember always: it's a **church** we are in, allow all people the opportunity for quiet prayer before and after Mass or any service.

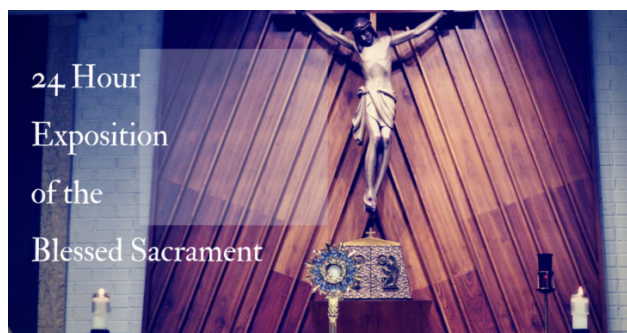

First Communion - Year One

Year One is for children who are just beginning the First Communion process. These children are typically in first grade, however, older children are welcome.

Fee is \$100.

(Preparation for First Communion is 2 years)

First Communion - Year Two

Year Two is for children who have **completed** Year One in the Sacramental formation process, no matter the grade.

Fee for Year Two is \$180.

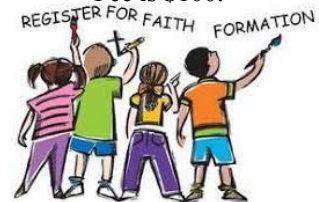
(The additional \$80 is to cover the cost of the Sacramental retreat).

A copy of your child's baptism certificate is mandatory before the first day of classes.

Faith Formation Grades 3, 4, 5

This part of our program is for families who wish to continue with the religious education of their children.

Fee is \$100.



REGISTRATION FOR THE 18-19 CONFIRMATION YEAR IS OPEN

The process to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation at St. Juliana Falconieri involves participating in our 2-year preparation program which primarily involves discipleship, catechesis, service, & retreats. Our program runs from September to May, with your teen receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation at the end of his/her second year. FIRST YEAR PARENT-TEEN MEETINGS

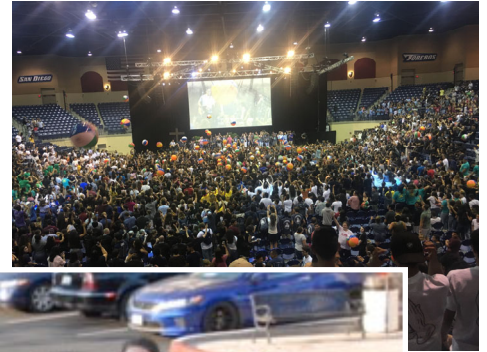


