A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

The Catholic grammar school keeps the parish from being b-o-r-i-n-g! The school community is a joy in so many ways. The joy is that we raise another generation of faith-filled disciples. I've said it so often it must be b-o-r-i-n-g, the purpose of the Catholic – all Christian - schools is to evangelize, to teach Jesus Christ, so the students form a relationship with Jesus. The Christian school will be successful when its students form a relationship with Jesus and imitate him, period. Not when the football team wins, not when fund-raising goals are reached or broken, not when the students have “successful” (make lots of money) jobs, but the school fulfills its purpose when the students and their families are faithful to Jesus. That's the purpose of Catholic education in its totality. We pray: “Open our eyes to the needs of our brothers and sisters; inspire in us (compassionate) words and (merciful) actions to comfort those who labor and are burdened. Make us serve (everybody) truly, after the example of Christ and at his command (to love one another). And may your Church stand as a living witness to truth and freedom, to peace and justice, that all people may be raised up to a new hope.” *Eucharistic Prayer IV for various needs* – “Jesus, Who Went about Doing Good” - parenthesis added. We teach our students to practice Christianity.

As pastor, and every adult involved with our school are pastors in the greater sense, our duty is clear; to make certain that through our students “all people are raised up to a new hope.” As we proclaim at the end of Mass, so do we teach: “Let us glorify the Lord by the way we live our lives.”

The Catholic school has a double duty in civic society; to form good citizens for the State as all schools do **AND to form good citizens for the Kingdom of God.** It's the ministry of making saints! **Of all the many tasks I do, there is not one that I enjoy more than teaching our students – your children at Mass. Please join us for school Masses on Tuesday 8:00AM for kindergarten, first, second grades, Wednesday, third, fourth, and fifth grades, and Friday, sixth, seventh, and eighth grades. On Thursday, January 31 a whole student body Mass will be celebrated in the church at 10:30AM. Together attend Mass, then have a good lunch. When we pray as a community we give clear witness that we all want formation in faithfulness. Pray the Mass then eat as a community. It's just better when we are all together.**

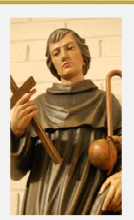

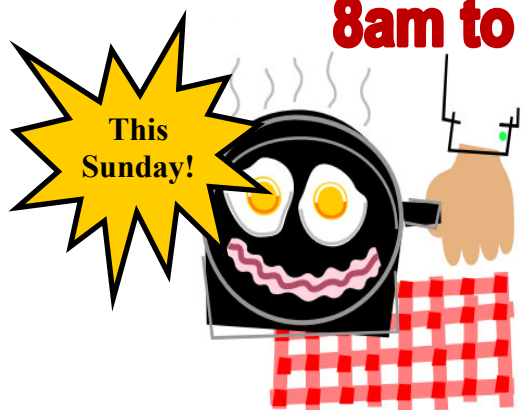

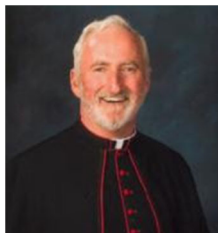
