### A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M



When someone calls you a “fool” stop and ask: “Why are you calling me a fool”? Take a deep breath, listen to understand not to respond immediately. Just try it!

Now, take a deep breath, read the Gospel lesson, and reflect on this: What do you do when it’s Jesus who says: “You fool”?

So, you live “the American Dream” in beautiful and bountiful East Fullerton, California, USA. Comfortable home, reliable car, work that gives your life dignity, a stable family, diploma from reputable college, and it is all paid for. And you want more. There is evidence that the guy in today’s Gospel lesson was living “bigly”. As Saint Francis Albert Sinatra sang, “*I’ve got the world on a string*”. What comes after ordinary abundance, super-abundance? When does abundance bring satisfaction and satisfaction, success? Apart from penicillin, what do you give the guy who has everything?

Define “satisfaction” or “success”. For many years I tried to teach Catholic school students the meaning of success. I asked what they thought it means: “Well, it’s like, like you know, being happy. It’s having it all.” Their answers were sufficiently vague as to lack meaning. You cannot achieve a vague goal. Not one mention of a relationship with God or salvation. We were, after all, in a Catholic environment some for the thirteenth year! God should have been rooted in their lives after years of Catholic brain-washing.

The fellow in the Gospel was a “fool” because he was living in excess without an awareness of God. “Moderation is a fatal thing. Nothing succeeds like excess” - said Oscar Wilde. Consider this, a lot of success was achieved with failure. How many times did Ted Williams or Joe DiMaggio strike out, how many free throws did Kobe Bryant or LeBron James miss, remember when Greg Louganis hit the diving board on his way to the water? How many hours did Frank Sinatra practice the song before he had the world on a string? Their success came from their excess - of practice.

Living what we believe to be the fullness of life, we often forget to practice the most important lesson; being aware of God and His love, forming a relationship with Jesus His Son, allowing the Holy Spirit to enlighten and guide

Listen for and to the voice of God. Today, practice the act of praying. Each day practice raising your hearts and minds to God. **Practice the acts of prayer:** Adoration (praise), Contrition, Thanksgiving, Supplication (petitioning) Him.

God is not calling you a “fool” because you are happy and successful. As long as you are aware of Him, there is no need to feel guilty for the achievements you’ve worked for which provide you with life. The question is: **Is God gloried by the way you live your life?** Jesus came to bring abundant life – Christians are successful when they imitate Christ.

**FOCUS missionary disciple Adam Ybarra will be begin ministry with us during the coming week. FOCUS will help with daily Evangelization in our parish – making the Good News of Jesus known and lived in our faith community. I need help! Adam is a single adult male age forty-six.
