A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M

I invite you to turn your prayerful attention to today's second reading from St. Paul to Timothy. St. Paul addressed two of his three "pastoral letters" to Timothy. Paul converted Timothy from Jewish and Gentile roots to Christianity. Timothy became a companion of Paul on various missionary journeys. We are reading the first letter, next week we will have a short meditation from the second one.

Today St. Paul encourages us to continue our baptismal journey; grow in the life of faith toward Jesus. All the days of your life "fight the good fight of faith", "keep the commandments", "direct your life to the Lord alone; give to him honor and eternal power."

Now, pause, sit down, and take a deep breath. Quiet yourself. Imagine that Fr. Luke is writing these words to you as a farewell talk.

Brothers and sisters, I do not know an easy way to tell you what follows, nor should there be an easy way. I am sad to share some important news with you. Next week, Fr Luke will return to Chicago to live. His health needs require him to make a transition. After conversation with our Prior Provincial and consideration of various options, Fr. Luke has concluded that Our Lady of Sorrows Servite Monastery in Chicago is the best residence for him. Three nurses staff OLS; it provides the opportunity for community prayer and prepared meals. Many priests and brothers live there, including Frs. Frank Falco and Paul Gins. There will never be a shortage of conversation!

Father fell in his bedroom twice during the summer. These were medical falls, not trips. Each fall required care at St. Jude Hospital followed by transitional care at Fountain Skilled Nursing in Fullerton. After the first incident, he returned home to St. Juliana. Following the second, he transitioned to "assisted living" at Sunny Crest in Fullerton. Now he is transiting to Our Lady of Sorrows - the Servite retirement center in Chicago.

Everyone enjoys a favorite image of Fr. Luke, predominately his compassionate presence. For that example alone we admire and love Fr. Luke. The Constitutions of the Order Friar Servants of Mary directs each friar thusly: #52 "In our journey towards perfect charity, we fall and make mistakes because of human weakness. For this reason, in our relationships we should live according to the Lord's admonition: "Be compassionate just as your Father is compassionate; forgive and you will be forgiven."

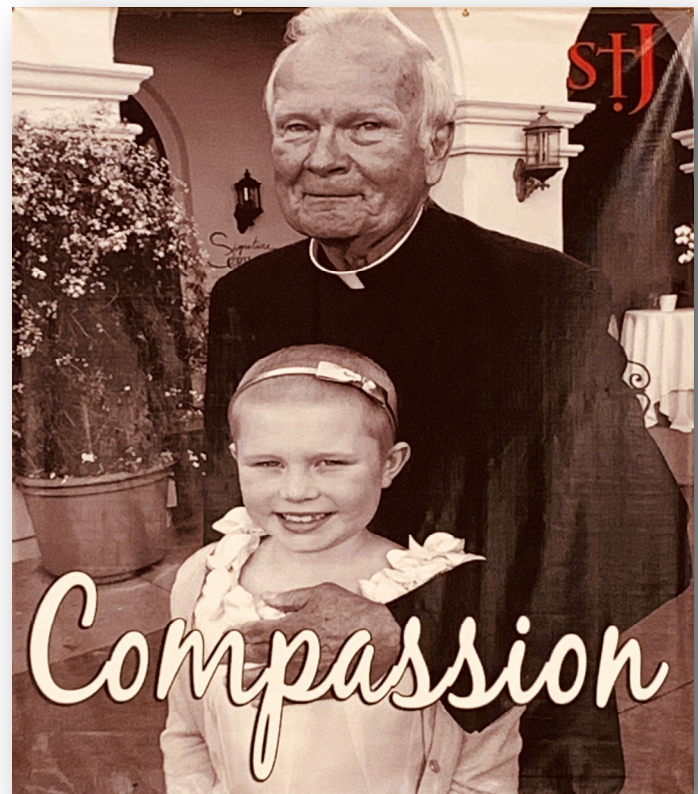
Compassion is recognized as the characteristic of the Servants, who continue in their life, the example of the Mother of God."

It was not a random arbitrary act, but the guide of Providence that a beautiful banner of Fr. Luke with Mia Rugienius hangs in our Pastoral Center. It is the picture of COMPASSION, a pillar of the grammar school and charism of the Servite Order. One banner, thousands of lasting memories.

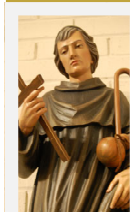

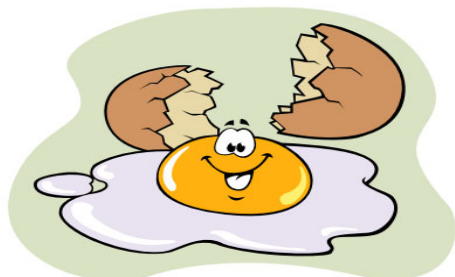

HOW GOD INTENDS US TO LIVE

Today's readings are again directed to believers, communities of faith. As in last week's reading, Amos confronts us with a condemnation of those whose lives are focused on pleasure and self-absorption. The psalm contrasts that focus with the Lord's—justice for the oppressed; food the hungry; freedom for captives; sight to the blind; raising of those who are bowed down; loving the just; protecting strangers, orphans, and the widow; and by doing so, thwarting the way of the wicked. Timothy urges the pursuit of righteousness, devotion, faith, love, patience, and gentleness. Luke tells the familiar tale of the wealthy man and the poor beggar at his doorstep, who experience life very differently in this world and in the next. We are once again being given clear indications about how God intends for us to live our lives.
