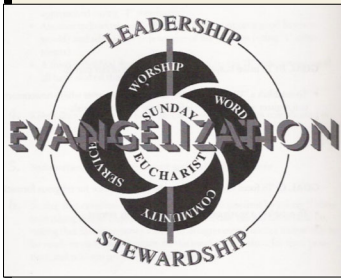

Message from the Pastor, Rev. Michael Pontarelli O.S.M

In Christ, all people are members of one body, his body. In Christ we are joined to be one living being for the Lord and his use. It is in Christ's love that we are joined together. In our community called Church, each one of us is important. The Spirit of God rests on each of us. As disciples, this Spirit teaches us. As apostles, the Spirit sends us to make the world God's Kingdom.

Our church community of St. Juliana is a living organism – it is the Body of Christ in this region. We are all one community, united in Christ. Led by God, we accomplish great deeds when we live in him and in love, serve him. I bring you words of thanks and a weekend up-date – the Weekend News, not Saturday Night Live style!

Today is January 23, we recently went past the 22 month mark of livestream Masses. We are grateful and give thanks to Deacon Tom Saenz and his wife Blanca, Mr. Bod Dietterle, Mrs Yolanda Doidge, and a host of others who got us started. Let us now recognize more and newer volunteers who keep us on YouTube as St. Juliana Church, Fullerton every day. The daily mass gets between 80-90 views –that is “hits” nearly every day. That is not the number of viewers – just individual hits to St Juliana Church Livestream on YouTube. When several people watch on one device, the actual number of viewers is certainly grater. Sunday Mass gets about 250 such hits. As time goes on the numbers grow larger. Months from now the number will be greater than 250 “hits”. People must be bored! No, no - our production is good and our Mass and message is acceptable to many.

Recently I received these two notes:

“Dear Fr Mike: Thank you for everything you do for our parish. Thank you especially for the Livestream Mass every day.” Enclosed was a check for \$1500.00

“Father Michael, thanks for keeping the 6:30AM internet Mass. I watch it 5 or 6 times each week before I start my day. ... In addition to the above I appreciate your short to the point homily. Also, the internet allows me to replay it if I miss a point. I have started jotting down a sentence or two from the homily and reviewing it at a later time. ... I believe you are reaching more people than you think, many like me don't subscribe or indicate in any way that they are watching.”

Attending Mass in person, you might notice – our attendance is still below the “pre-pandemic” numbers. This is quite common among parishes especially among Anglo parishes. In the Diocese of Orange, parishes like ours report a drop of between 20-40% on Sundays. St. Juliana follows the trend of “numbers are down, collections are good to great”. I thank you for coming to Mass and your regular contributions to our ministry. You encourage us to continue. You trust us. For your expression of trust, we are grateful. If you are indeed sick, please stay home. You do not sin by not attending Mass if you are ill. You are encouraged to attend Mass in person. Join the community and receive the Blessed Sacrament.

PSA (Pastoral Services Appeal) 2022 will begin soon. PSA pamphlets are in the pews, they will soon be in your regular mail. Notice our own Deacon Darrell Miller and his wife Kelly on the pamphlet! Our PSA assessment to the Diocese of Orange is \$121K. It would be higher - but – we give \$10K as a gift to St. Anthony parish in Anaheim. We have to raise the money! This gift to our neighbor in need reduces our assessment. Last year we contributed \$16K to St. Anthony's Parish. Charitable gifts are always discussed and they pass the approval of the Parish Finance Committee. I hope you agree that it is important to share our resources with a parish in need.

PSA 2021, is completed. Your generous contribution above the diocesan assessment gave us a rebate of \$50,147. That surplus will be split between worship and faith formation. Previously the PSA rebate was split three ways including an endowment fund. Last year, the parish received a bequest that contributed \$1Million to the endowment fund. For that reason, the endowment fund will not be considered this year. The parish endowment is now nearly \$1,200,000. That's some good news!

Major expenses on the horizon include – a new perimeter fence, enhanced lighting in the sanctuary area, and a new piano for the choir.

The perimeter fence is already budgeted and planned for.

The sanctuary lighting project: current sanctuary lighting can use an enhancement. I have a professional looking into the matter. It MIGHT be as simple as new light bulbs.

A new piano for the choir. Here's the issue, our choir/church piano was given to the parish as a hand-me-down many years ago. It now needs major repairs. A new one is the answer. Our choir director, Mr. Todd Helm, has researched the matter. A new piano is in the \$35,000.00 range. We prefer a new and not a used one even from a school of music.

Mr. Curtis Wesseln has found some donors. If you would like to contribute, please contact the office. The church organ was replaced perhaps nine years ago. Music is essential in our worship as we give honor and glory to Almighty God.

Lastly, please gear up for a Lenten series on the liturgy. How it will be presented is uncertain at this time. There will be a Lenten series and it will be on the liturgy, the Mass. Once more, thank you for being the great parish you are.

God bless you, each one.
