


VISION & MISSION STATEMENTS



be, have ready those touchstones, those "go to" prayers or phrases that you can hold onto during the times when you are sorely tested in your life. Let those stones be your firm foundation.



- \diamond Deacon Pete accepted a \$500.00 dollar donation for a new piano for the church.






THINGS TO LOOK FORWARD TO
