


VISION & MISSION STATEMENTS

A message from Dr. Manel Gonzales Jr. Principal of St. Juliana School

Dear Saint Juliana Parish Community,

The 2023–2024 school year presented us with a unique set of challenges as we worked diligently to recover from the lasting effects of the COVID-19 pandemic on our school enrollment which affected our school budget. These challenges tested our resilience, but they also reminded us of the strength found in our shared mission and faith.

Amid these trials, we were heartened to observe positive trends in both school enrollment and budget stability. These upward movements reflect not only improvement but also a testament to the unwavering commitment and dedication of our entire school community. Such growth signals that Saint Juliana Falconieri School is moving in a direction of hope and renewal, guided by our collective effort and trust in God's providence. The actual cost to educate a student during the 2023/24 school year was \$8,338. This figure was determined by calculating the total expenses, subtracting other sources of income, and dividing the remaining amount by the 275 students enrolled at the end of the school year.

For the same year, the tuition rates were \$7,680 for parish-participating families and \$9,180 for non-parish families. This results in a \$658 per-student shortfall between the actual cost and the average tuition collected. To bridge this gap, parish contributions covered \$43,592, with the remaining balance addressed through fundraising efforts, which rely on the dedication and support of our parent community. Your volunteer work in fundraising is an essential component of balancing the budget and ensuring the continued success of our school.

While we recognize there is still much work to be done, I want to express my heartfelt gratitude to our school community—parents, students, faculty, staff, alumni, and supporters—for their generosity and steadfast belief in our mission. Your contributions, whether through time, resources, or prayer, have been instrumental in helping us move forward. Together, we are building a foundation for continued success and ensuring that Saint Juliana Falconieri School remains a place where faith and education thrive hand in hand.

Thank you for your ongoing support and dedication. May we continue to walk forward in faith and unity, in-


