



ST. ISADORE NEXT GENERATION FOUNDATION

NEWSLETTER AUGUST 5, 2024



Greetings dear Friends,

I admit that these updates tend to come far in between... however, St. Isidore works and my main ministry as chaplain at the college, are progressing well. In this issue, I wish to report on what we have accomplished, ongoing projects, and what we have learned. Firstly, I want to thank you immensely for your ongoing support, both financially and spiritually to facilitate the success of this ministry!

St. Isidore Next Generation Foundation (SING) started as back in 2017 a small charity arrangement, later we added some elementary community farming to provide work, food, and protein to the local community of Kakubansiri village, Gomba district – Uganda. Within the last two years it has now expanded into a significantly bigger charity Foundation with its own 501c3 (87-4488255), committed to Education of our young, youth empowerment and skills training, rural community development by providing clean water and electricity, community engagement in climate protection activities, and outreach to the vulnerable elderly.

From the Desk of Fr. Raphael



St. Isidore Foundation currently sponsors tuition for 50 students: 20 in Elementary, 20 in high school, and 10 in college.

Youth leadership Camp/retreat: This year in April we hosted over 100 youths at the farm for three days for a leadership and life skills camp. This is the third time doing this, and each year it gets bigger, intense, and more meaningful.

Within the last year May 2023 a new coop. This has enabled us to expand our poultry program to almost 10,000 birds! Electricity: In December 2023, we finally managed to bring hydroelectricity to the center. This has breathed new life to the center and made our activities so much easier than it has ever been. Other Successes: Our pigs are doing quite well. We have fully recovered from the last swine fever that devastated us two years ago. We currently have 41 pigs, 60 goats, 9 cows, and a thriving bees project that provides honey and pollination for our crops. Regarding the crops, we have expanded our coffee garden from five to ten acres this year. We grow beans, maize, bananas, lemons, and have about 150 fruit trees including mangoes, jackfruit, and papaya.

STUDENTS CENTER




In the summer of 2022 we embarked on the construction of our Students Center. At this point we have spent approximately \$200,000 for the construction and furnishing - functional with electricity and running water. I am happy to report, that while it's not entirely complete, we have started using it for retreats, camping, and mentorship trainings. We are currently working on paving the outdoor grounds, and a larger set of washrooms
