
VISION & MISSION STATEMENTS





Fr. Luke (Joseph) M. Stano, O.S.M.

On Thursday, February 13, 2025, at 10:15 PM (CST) [22:15], Father Luke M. (Joseph) Stano, O.S.M., a solemn professed friar and priest of the United States of America Province, assigned de familia to Our Lady of Sorrows Community in Chicago, Illinois, succumbed to complications of Parkinson's disease at Citadel Scalabrini Care Center where he had been in hospice care for the last eight months.

Fr. Luke was 88 years old and a professed friar for 69 (p.p. on 8/28/55) years. He was born on February 27, 1936; professed solemn vows on October 5, 1958; and was ordained to the priesthood on May 27, 1961.
